

MILITARY 4th QUARTER 2016

OCTOBER

10/02– WWII VETS RETURN FROM HONOR FLIGHT – :45

Nearly a hundred WWII vets and Vietnam vets returned to San Diego after visiting Washington, D.C. as part of the “tour of honor flight.”

10/7 – USS Fort Worth Returns – TRT: 0:25

The USS Fort Worth is coming back to San Diego after being sidelined for most of the year, as the littoral combat ship broke down on its maiden deployment.

10/14– Makin Island deployment – TRT 1:30

This morning the Makin Island amphibious ready group are scheduled to deploy

10/20- Battle For Mosul Latest: TRT: 1:39

An American service member has been killed during the fighting in Northern Iraq. There are reports the service member was part of the operation to take Mosul back from ISIS control.

10/21- Coronado Based Sailor Killed- TRT: :35

The latest American killed in the fight against Isis was a Coronado based sailor specializing in “de-arming and destroying bombs.”

10/26–National Guard members ordered to pay back bonuses– TRT 0:25

Nearly ten-thousand California Army National Guard soldiers have to repay enlistment bonuses-- a decade after signing.

NOVEMBER

11/03– Iraq Troops enter Mosul – TRT 0:28

"Two American troops" and "30 afghan people" have been killed in a battle to fight the Taliban in Afghanistan.

11/09 – Military jets collide – TRT - 1:30

Two fighter jets based at Miramar crashed in mid-air just a few hours ago. Both pilots were able to get out of the planes.

11/11 Homeland Diaries SAT – TRT 3:00

Interview with Corporal Todd Nicely—a veteran injured in Afghanistan, and the focus of the documentary “Homeland Diaries.”

11/13– PINTS AND PADDLE EVENT FOR WOUNDED VETS – :45

San Diegans spent the weekend fundraising for wounded veterans. The “Pints and Paddles” event featured a two mile kayak race and paddle boarding.

11/14– USS John P Murtha arrives in SD today– TRT :19

A brand new warship will now call San Diego home later today.

11/15- Poway Affordable Housing for Veterans Vote – TRT: 1:36

A group of residents in Poway are against a proposed development that would create affordable housing for veterans. The residents say the construction and traffic in the area will be a mess. The project was voted down 3-2.

11/18– USS John P. Murtha Arrival – TRT: 0:25

San Diego’s newest Navy ship, the USS John P. Murtha, pulled into port today after doing sea trials over the summer in the Gulf of Mexico.

DECEMBER

12/01– Marine helicopter precautionary landing – TRT - 1:30

Officials at MCAS Miramar tell us a Marine aircraft from. The aircraft is an MV22 Osprey Tilt rotor and it’s expected to remain at the ranch overnight. Base officials tell us the pilots were conducting routine training and landed because aircraft instruments indicted a potential maintenance issue. No one was injured.

12/02– Osprey precautionary landing – TRT 1:30

The osprey that made a precautionary landing yesterday is still perched on a local ranch.

12/07- 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF PEARL HARBOR ATTACK VO TRT :20 SEC

12/08 – USS Zumwalt Arrives in San Diego –0:30

After delays due to breaking down, the USS Zumwalt arrived in its new homeport of San Diego.

12/11– ISRAEL TO BUY 35 FIGHTER JETS FROM LOCKHEED MARTIN – :25

The first of two F-35 stealth fighter jets arrived in Israel. The country purchased 35 of the jets from Lockheed Martin which has offices in San Diego.

12/12- Chris Pratt at MCAS Miramar Screening – TRT: 1:45

There was some real star power at MCAS Miramar tonight. Actor Chris Pratt dropped in for a special showing of his new movie. He met with Marines for a special screening.

12/13– Osprey Crash Japan – TRT :18

The U-S marine corps confirms an osprey crashed off the coast of Okinawa. All five crew members were rescued-- and are being treated for injuries.

12/19 –Vote on sending troops to Aleppo– TRT 0:20

The U.N. considers sending monitors to keep people safe in Aleppo. Russia has threatened to veto the planned security council resolution -- before reportedly striking a deal with France.

12/20– Housing Our Heroes – TRT: 0:50

More than 700 homeless veterans in San Diego are now enrolled in a city-wide program to help them get off the streets.
