Officer Manuel Ramos is charged with 2nd degree murder and involuntary manslaughter, while Corporal Jay Cincinelli is charged with involuntary manslaughter and excessive use of force. Ramos and Cincinelli along with 4 other officers confronted 37-year old Kelly Thomas at a Fullerton bus depot in July. When Thomas resisted arrest, the officers beat him. He died of his injuries. Both officers are out on bail.</p>
