

Purpose of Amendment

The WDVM 3Q 2019 report is hereby amended to correct the errors in the digital core programming summary to update the total number of core programming hours on both the primary and multicast streams, thereby showing compliance with the FCC Children's television programming rules. The amendment also corrects certain reporting errors in the time and frequency in which the following programs aired: (i) Digital Core Program 2 of 20; Digital Core Program 4 of 20; Digital Core Program 5 of 20; Digital Core Program 11 of 20; and Digital Core Program 17 of 20.

With the use of a new Form 2100 form for children's programming reports, WDVM is no longer able to amend the 3Q 2019 report via the FCC LMS system, and is therefore uploading this amended report to its online public inspection file.
