Radio License Holding CBC, LLC, an indirect subsidiary of Cumulus Media Inc. ("Cumulus"), is the licensee of Station KFOG(AM), Little Rock, Arkansas (Fac. ID No. 24150). This Station appeared on the list associated with the October 30, 2023, EEO Audit Letter ("the Letter") that identified stations randomly selected for an EEO audit. KFOG is part of the Cumulus-Little Rock, Arkansas station employment unit ("SEU") with commonly owned Stations KLAL(FM), Wrightsville, Arkansas; KIPR(FM), Pine Bluff, Arkansas; KURB(FM), Little Rock, Arkansas; KAAY(AM), Little Rock, Arkansas; KARN(AM), Little Rock, Arkansas; and KARN-FM, Sheridan, Arkansas.

Cumulus respectfully requests an extension of time to respond to the Letter. The FCC's December 1, 2023, filing deadline for numerous biennial ownership reports and annual EEO reports along with other FCC-related projects has kept its FCC counsel very busy. In order to assemble the documentation requested in the Letter and present a well-organized and thorough response, Cumulus respectfully requests an extension of time, until December 28, 2023, to complete its reply.
