## **I. ECONOMY/POVERTY/TAXES**

Jerry Escalante and Dr. Roger Gonzalez discussed the high taxes in El Paso as opposed to the taxes in other areas of the southwest. The property taxes in Dona Ana County which is directly adjacent to El Paso are approximately 60% lower than in El Paso. This has caused some people whose income is at below poverty levels to lose their homes.

Pastor Antonio Galvan has a rehabilitation center in Juarez, Mexico and deals with people that are picked up off the streets when it is very cold and run the risk of even death. They also talked about how on some cases, the head of household does not return to their homes and eventually even stop sending money to meet the families needs.

Pastor Tencha Carmona shared how her husband remained unemployed for 26 months and how after his unemployment had run out she had to get another job to make ends meet. Pastor Carmona discussed how Mr. Carmona felt about the fact that even though he was seeking employment, he was not able to obtain it that caused strife and contention in the home. Both were very grateful that Mr. Carmona was able to find employment and relieve her of the second job.

Pastor Alberto Weber and Luis Ortiz discussed having to close his small business due to the lack of skilled employees. His small business is a cabinet shop that produced custom made cabinets for kitchens and other domestic needs. Mr. Ortiz had to close his business after a number of clients returned custom made cabinets because the work was not acceptable. He attributed it to the employees that were not qualified to do the work.



### **3. EDUCATION / SCHOOLS / TEACHERS / STUDENTS.**

He commented on how the system had changed radically since the arrest and eventual incarceration of the former superintendent. The firing of several public school officials also caused a number of problems for students who fell victims to the shenanigans that were taking place. Mr. Sanchez stated that some of these students, who had been dismissed, had now been re-instated.

The same has happened in Canutillo, Texas as well as other communities in our region such as Clint and other towns.

## **5. VIOLENCE: BORDER & CD. JUAREZ**

Pastor Jose Antonio Galvan talked about the ongoing violence that has been lived in Juarez since 2007 and how at times it seems to subside but then it starts up again. Businesses have reopened in Juarez and the numbers of daily murders has gone down but there is still a marked violence in the city. One of the greatest fears of the city's citizens, is the number of kidnappings for ransom that occur daily.
