#### WAGH Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WAGH provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Driving Safety: Thousands of people have been killed by distracted drivers; hundreds of thousands more injured. Casey Feldman was just 21 years old when she was struck by a distracted driver and killed in 2009. Her father, Joel Feldman, discusses the Casey Feldman Foundation and the End distracted Driving initiative which works to change our driving culture.
- Education: Make-A-Wish Georgia works diligently every day to grant the wishes of children with life-threatening medical conditions across the state.
