## **COMMUNITY**

1. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 5:00am, July 3, 2012, Length: 1:45:** Three hundred sailors deployed from Naval Station Norfolk today. The sailors will be gone for seven months, and are scheduled to serve in the Mediterranean and Arabian Seas. The ship and its crew have been preparing for this mission for several months.
2. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 18, 2012, Length: 2:00:** When a military honor guard isn't available, members of VFW 6060 in Elizabeth City perform the honors for a veteran's funeral. The post 6060 honor guard is the only one like within 500 miles, so the van they use to get around racks up a lot of miles. Their 1986 GMC Vandura isn't very reliable any more. So NewsChannel 3 told viewers about their need for a new van. And viewers doubled the post's fundraising efforts, making it possible for them to buy a new one, so they don't miss a funeral.
3. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 8, 2012 Length 1:15** Citizens group "Citizens Against Unfair Tolls" meet to get an update on a proposed lawsuit over tolls at the downtown and midtown tunnels. They hope courts will find the tolls unconstitutional.
4. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, September 29, 2012 Length :30** City of Virginia Beach holds parade for home town hero and Olympic gold medalist Gabby Douglas. She waved to the crowd along with Virginia Beach Mayor Will Sessoms as they drove down the parade route along Atlantic Avenue at the oceanfront.
5. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, September 22, 2012 Length :40** Long lines in Norfolk as folks got a chance to chow down on barbecue and ribs. Part of the Rib-fest in Town Point Park. BBQ Restaurants from around the area cook up the mouth water food for people to sample.
6. **NewsChannel 3 at 6:00pm, August 31, 2012 Length :30** Saint Gregory The Great Christian school had a special day of learning. Children brought their grandparents to class with them.
7. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, August 25, 2012, Length :45** New shoes given out to children at the First United Presbyterian Church to help families who can't afford them. Shoes were collected by the non-profit group "A thousand shoes for a thousand smiles".

## **CONSUMER ADVOCACY**

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, July 9, 2012, Length: 0:25:** More law enforcement agencies are tapping into what we do and say on our phones. According to a congressional report, cell phone carriers received about 1.3 million demands for information from law enforcement agencies last year. And there have been cases where carriers reported unjustified requests for information. Officials say cell surveillance is important, since there's, "some type of mobile device at every crime scene." But the ACLU says some agencies have been gathering data on people who don't even have a real connection to a crime.
2. **Newschannel 3 at 4:00pm July 12, 2012 Length 2:00** Segment on back to school shopping in July and how preparing now can save money rather than waiting for the official back to school sales.

3. **NewsChannel 3 at 6:00 pm August 18, 2012 Length 2:00.** Dry conditions in parts of the country known for wine, is helping wineries. More people coming to wineries for tasting and tours and with the dry conditions, businesses owners are able to put out more wine for patrons.
4. **Newschannel 3 at 4:00pm September 12, 2012 Length 2:00** McDonald's restaurants helping customers make better decisions on food choices by adding calorie counts on the menu.

## **CRIME/DRUGS**

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 26, 2012, Length: 1:30:** First, a big break. Portsmouth's longest-running fugitive was arrested yesterday. He had been on the run since 2005. Jason Lamont Trusty was spotted yesterday in a car on Bagley Street. Portsmouth police are crediting U.S. Marshals and the tenacious efforts of their officers for finally finding him. Trusty's name should sound familiar to NewsChannel 3 viewers. We profiled his case several times on NewsChannel 3 over the past two-and-a-half years. Trusty is facing drug and gun charges from 2005. He is also wanted by state police for not complying with the sex offender registry. Police are thanking NewsChannel 3 for working with them to keep Trusty's case in the news.
2. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, July 6, 2012, Length: 1:35:** A judge has set bail at \$1,000,000 for George Zimmerman, who is accused of shooting and killing unarmed Florida teen Trayvon Martin. The case has divided the country. Zimmerman claims he shot Martin in self defense. Prosecutors claim Zimmerman overstepped his rights as a neighborhood watch leader, killing Martin in cold blood.
3. **NewsChannel 3 at 4:00pm, July 17, 2012. Length :30:** Updates on case following since just after Fourth Of July holiday weekend. An Ohio woman vacationing in the Outer Banks of North Carolina found dead. Search is on for her ex-boyfriend who was with her and took her children back to Ohio.
4. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 1, 2012 Length 1:00** Police are looking for man after a Virginia Beach woman said someone robbed her at gunpoint outside of her house. It happened early Monday morning when the woman was walking to her car.
5. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, August 11, 2012 Length :30** Chesapeake Police believe a home invasion could be linked to a triple-shooting. Three people robbed at a home on Walnut Avenue, moments later police say three people were shot nearby on Cardover Avenue.
6. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 13, 2012 Length :30** A shooting and an underage party take place at the same Norfolk Hotel at the same time. A mother is charged with delinquency of minors. Police are looking for the person who shot a man. No word if the two events are connected.
7. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, September 9, 2012 Length 1:30** A North Carolina State trooper dies after trying to stop a man during a high speed chase.
8. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 14, 2012 Length :30** A man wanted for two murders and several shootings was caught last night in Newport News

## ECONOMY

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:00pm, July 6, 2012, Length: 0:25:** The June jobs report did not have good news for people looking for work. The Labor Department says only 80,000 jobs were added last month. The unemployment rate held steady at 8.2%. More than 12-million Americans are out of work. They average amount of time on unemployment is 40 weeks.
2. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:00pm, July 4, 2012, Length: 0:25:** Rumors of Apple adding a new mini-iPad to their collection. Believed to be available by the end of the year. Experts call it a competitor's worse nightmare.
3. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012, Length 0:30:** JC Penney is getting rid of cashiers in order to save money. Customers will use a self-checkout. New changes will take place by 2014.
4. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 3, 2012, Length 0:30:** Today the July jobs numbers will come out. Economist predict 100,000 jobs added while unemployment stays the same.
5. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 14, 2012, Length :30,** Banks are looking for ways to add new fees according to a new survey. Banks are trying to make up funds lost due to the limit they can charge stores for debit uses.
6. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, August 17, 2012, Length: 0:25:** The city of Franklin celebrated the start up of its new fluff pulp plant. Fluff pulp is a product used to make diapers. International Paper closed the city's paper mill in 2010 because it didn't have enough demand for paper. Eleven-hundred people lost their jobs. At the end of June, 213 people started working at the mill again. International Paper invested about \$90 million to get the company started up again.
7. **NewsChannel 3 At Noon, September 7, 2012 Length, :25** Disappointing jobs report. In August Employers created fewer jobs than hoped. The department of Labor reports the jobless rate fell to 8.1%.
8. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 12, 2012 Length :30** The new iPhone 5 is expected to be released today. Economist believe it could be a shot in the arm for the economy.

## EDUCATION

1. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, July 12, 2012, Length: 0:30:** The new president of the University of Virginia, Teresa Sullivan, is on a mission to repair the university's reputation after a bitter debate over whether she should remain as president. Sullivan traveled to Georgia to meet with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. The organization decides whether colleges or universities are accredited. The meeting is a response to a letter sent by the organization, which says the controversy surrounding Sullivan's removal and reinstatement raises questions about integrity and the faculty's role in governing the school. Last month, the Board of Visitors forced Sullivan to resign. But after protests from students, faculty, and alumni, the board later decided to reinstate her.
2. **NewsChannel 6 at 6:00pm, July 16, 2012, Length: 1:45:** Isle of Wight Public Schools has decided to replace its textbooks with 2,000 iPads for students. The school district will spend

about \$3,000,000 on the tablets. Administrators say they aren't having to cut programs to afford the devices, because the district had the money in-hand already. They say the electronic textbooks will always be current, students will stay current with technology, and they won't have to carry around four to seven heavy textbooks.

3. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 9, 2012 Length :20** Tuition for Colleges in Virginia are going up. The highest increase will be nearly 5% at Christopher Newport University.
4. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, August 29, 2012 Length :40** A hearing impaired preschooler banned from signing his own name at school. School officials say his hands make it look like he's firing a gun.
5. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 10, 2012 Length :30** Today 30,000 teachers and support staff will go on strike in Chicago. Union leaders say they have not reached an agreement with the school board.

## ENVIRONMENT

1. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning, 6:00am, July 18, 2012, Length: 1:35:** More than half of the U.S. is now in some state of drought. The dry weather is affecting the harvest for farmers. The lower yield also means that consumers will soon pay more for food in grocery stores.
2. **NewsChannel 3 First at 4:00pm, July 26, 2012, Length: 0:25:** There are updates on a pair of swimming advisories in Dare County, North Carolina. One advisory at mile marker 15 off South Virginia Trail in Nags Head was lifted today. That advisory is on the ocean-side swimming area. But an advisory posted on Ocean Bay Boulevard in Kill Devil Hills is still in effect. The advisory does not close the entire beach; just the area within 200 feet of the posted sign.
3. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, August 9, 2012 :20** NASA Curiosity rover may have landed on a martian crater, but could just be somewhere in California. That's what NASAS scientists say after studying the photos and video the Mars rover beamed back to earth.
4. **NewsChannel 3 At Noon, August 22, Length 0:25:** Developing wildfire in California spreads nearly out of control. Forces mandatory evacuations in the northing part of the state. Nearly 3,500 people could be in harm's way if fire is not contained soon.
5. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 19, 2012 Length :30** Later today Space Shuttle Endeavour will leave Florida for California where it will go on permanent display.

## FOREIGN AFFAIRS

1. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, July 12, 2012, Length :30** The US is considering keeping 2 aircraft carriers in the Persian Gulf through the end of the year. No word if Norfolk Based USS Enterprise will be one of them. The Enterprise is currently there on its final deployment.
2. **NewsChannel 3 At 11:00pm, July 15, 2012 Length, :30** Family of an American pastor kidnapped in Egypt is pleading for the man's release. The man's son says his father didn't realized the danger of traveling to the area.

3. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, August 17, 2012, Length: 0:25:** U.S. military officials say a uniformed Afghan police officer shot and killed two U.S. troops in Farah Province this morning. The gunman then killed himself. This is the second time in the last week a shooting like this has happened. Military officials say last Friday, a man dressed like an Afghan police officer shot and killed three U.S. soldiers.
4. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 30, 2012, Length 1:05:** A former member of Seal Team Six is talking about his book that accounts the raid that killed Bin Laden. CBS has released a portion of his interview from 60 minutes.
5. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 3, 2012 Length, :20** Two American's were killed today in a suicide bombing in Peshawar, Pakistan. It happened near a U.N. building when a car full of explosives crashed into another car.
6. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, September 7, 2012 Length, :25** Series of earthquakes have killed nearly 65 people in China. China's state-run news agency says the quake damaged about 20,000 homes and triggered landslides.
7. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 25, 2012 Length, :20** Amateur video shows rebels blowing up a Military tank. More than 27 thousand people have died in the uprising.

## HEALTH

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 7, 2012, Length :30** A 70-year-old woman cycling cross country rides into our area. She is riding for her non-profit group "Feed The Need – Emerald City Lights Bike Ride". All to fight hunger, bringing awareness.
2. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, July 6, 2012, Length: :25** FDA & anti-smoking groups believe e-cigarettes could be hazardous to your health. Citing the vapors inhaled, haven't been approved by the Feds. FDA says it plans to regulate e-cigarettes similar to other tobacco products.
3. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, August 3, 2012, Length: 1:35:** There's a new fitness craze gaining ground: barefoot running. Those who do it say it's better for the body. Not all run totally barefoot. Some wear a special running shoe that doesn't offer any support; they just protect the skin from hitting the ground. But doctors say there's no evidence that running barefoot is better than using sneakers. And they're treating many runners with injuries, especially when they first start running barefoot.
4. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, August 23, 2012, Length: 1:45:** A new study in Iceland suggests that despite convention wisdom that the age of the mother affects her child's chances of having a developmental disorder like autism, the opposite is actually true. Their study says a father's age could account for 15-30% of cases of autism, and perhaps other disorders like schizophrenia as well.

## POLITICS

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 13, 2012, Length: 2:00:** President Obama visited Hampton Roads today. He started the day in Norfolk, with two stops planned in Virginia Beach and Hampton. After landing at Norfolk International Airport, the President headed to Green Run High School in Virginia Beach, making an unannounced stop at Rick's Café along the way. After

speaking at the high school, Obama returned to Air Force One for a quick hop to Langley Air Force Base. He then made a quick visit to A Barefoot Bride Boutique before making his final appearance at Phoebus High School.

2. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, July 25, 2012 :20** Virginia Governor announces a special election to fill two vacancies in Virginia's General Assembly.
3. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 2, 2012 Length :30** Mitt Romney, the presumptive GOP presidential nominee will be in Virginia Beach on August 15th. The details have not been announced yet.
4. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, August 11, 2012, Length: 4:15:** Republican presidential candidate Mitt Romney introduced Wisconsin congressman Paul Ryan as his running mate at Nauticus. While Romney had scheduled his visit days in advance, the word that he would reveal his running mate came just hours before the rally.
5. **NewsChannel 3 at 4:00pm, August 21, 2012 2:00** MO Rep. Todd Akin and his comments on rape - he's refusing to drop out of the race for Senate.
6. **NewsChannel 3 At 6:00pm, September 1, 2012, Length, :30:** People lining up to get tickets to see President Obama for a scheduled stop in Norfolk ahead of the Democratic National Convention.
7. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 6, 2012 Length, 1:50** The Democratic Party nominated President Obama as their choice for President at last night's convention. Tonight the President will accept the nomination.

## RACE

1. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning, 6:00am, August 15, 2012, Length: 0:30:** The Transportation Safety Administration is investigating itself, after allegations of racial profiling. Some employees are accusing fellow co-workers of inappropriate screenings. They say TSA officers are targeting minorities for questioning based on their race or ethnicity. The claims, first reported in *The New York Times* prompted the TSA to open its internal investigation. The TSA says officers should flag passengers for additional screening based only on observed behaviors.
2. **NewsChannel 3 at Noon, September 21, 2012, Length, :35:** Texas man hung a chair from a tree to symbolize the President. The man says he was copying what Clint Eastwood did at the Republican National Convention. The man was accused of being racist and took the chair down following complaints.

## TRANSPORTATION

1. **NewsChannel 3 at 11:00pm, July 5, 2012, Length, :45** People upset over Colorado TSA agents checking drinks bought in the terminal section of the airport.
2. **NewsChannel 3 First at 4:00pm, August 2, 2012, Length: 1:30:** Investigators are looking into how three planes were sent on head-on courses near Reagan International Airport. Two planes

took off as an oncoming plane approached the airport. Controllers were in the process of changing the airports direction because of changing weather. For some reason, the message was not fully relayed to all controllers.

3. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 2, 2012, Length :30** The jets had a near mid-air collision on Tuesday after information about a pattern change did not get relayed to ATC. The plans all landed without any further incident.
4. **NewsChannel 3 at 5:30pm, August 8, 2012 Length, 1:40** Getting answers on when Hampton Roads' Transit will replace a bus shelter in downtown Norfolk. Riders say they've been waiting for the replacement since May.
5. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 3, 2012 Length, :20** There was a crash on 464 near the Pointdexter exit. State Police say it was the result of some kind chase. No official word from local police on what happened.
6. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 11, 2012 Length, :30** One person is dead after crash in Portsmouth. The man was walking in the street when he was hit. No word on any charges.
7. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 28, 2012 Length 1:30:** Two weeks after the traffic nightmare at the JRB and the HRBT- construction will resume at the JRB tonight. VDOT Closed off two of the three routes from the peninsula to the southside causing hours of backups. They put further work on hold until they came up with this new plan.

## SAFETY

1. **NewsChannel 3 First at 4:00pm, July 10, 2012, Length: 0:20:** The Washington Monument will be closed to visitors for at least another year. The monument was cracked during last year's earthquake, based in Mineral. A spokesperson with the National Park Service says repairs to make the monument's observation deck safe for visitors will take at least another year.
2. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, August 8, 2102, Length, :20** Investigators are trying to figure out what caused a fire last night on Baker Street in Portsmouth. No one was hurt in the fire.
3. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 5:00am, August 16, 2012, Length: 1:10:** Later today at NAS Oceana, the Navy will prepare for next month's air show with a mishap drill. Pilots will also practice touch-and-go landings from 7:00-10:00pm.
4. **NewsChannel 3 This Morning at 6:00am, September 5, 2012, Length, :40** Police have released the name of the boy who was shot and killed in his own home. Police are calling it an accident.
