People stampeded at an overcrowded street party with insufficient crowd control by authorities. The geographical characteristics of this area resulted in the business district developing mainly in narrow alleyways. Adding to the problem is the oftentimes illegal expansion and renovation in the district as well as the increased number of tourists to the area.

The Republican Party, which had been predicted to win the November 8 mid-term election in a landslide—the so called “Red Wave”—appeared to be winning in the House races by a much narrower margin. Instead of the Republicans gaining control in both chambers, the Democrats won comeback victories in Arizona and Nevada, thus ensuring Democratic control of the Senate regardless of the result of the December runoff election in Georgia.
