SUMMARY: The hospitality/food and beverage industry is one of the key components of the Lowcountry economy. It is also an occupation high in drug and alcohol abuse. Mickey Bakst, one of the co-founders of Ben's Friends, an organization founded specifically to help people in the hospitality industry dealing with addiction, why that is. The reasons include the stress of the profession, as well as the close proximity to alcohol to those working
