Many organizations from churches to youth groups, as well as local law enforcement and public safety entities avail themselves to this service.

Community Spiritual Needs	Long-form broadcast	4/7/19, and every Sunday thereafter.	Sunday, 7:00AM	30-45 Minutes	WBZX broadcasts the previous Sundays' service from the Barryton Church of Christ, allowing those who are homebound to experience a weekly church service.
Community Health Needs	Remote Broadcast	August 16th, 2019	Friday, Noon-3	3 Hours	Live Broadcast from Metron of Big Rapids, one of the areas' premiere elder care centers. During that community fair, we interviewed several members of the staff, not only about what Metron has to offer, but about elder health in general.

We strove to be more a part of the 4-H part of the fair, which meant taking our remote microphones to the barns and pavilions and interviewing the youth about their projects, what 4-H has taught them, and how they will use that knowledge in the future.
