

WAYS TO COMBAT DEPRESSION AND SUICIDE

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 7, 2018

GUEST: REGINA CREECH...INJURY PREVENTION COORDINATOR FOR MUSC'S LEVEL-1 TRAUMA CENTER.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE INCREASED INCIDENT OF DEPRESSION AND SUICIDE IN SOCIETY. THERE HAVE BEEN COUNTLESS STUDIES ON DEPRESSION...AND SUICIDE. DEPRESSION CAN BE EXPLAINED AS A MENTAL HEALTH CONDITION. FOR SOME THE CONDITION IS BAD ENOUGH TO 'END IT ALL'. OTHERS MANAGE DEPRESSION THROUGH RX DRUGS.

THE MAIN QUESTION IS WHY SOME RESORT TO SUICIDE. CREECH SAYS THE FEELING OF OVERWHELMING SADNESS IS TOO MUCH FOR SOME TO TAKE. THOSE WHO TRY COMMITTING SUICIDE ONCE AND ARE UNSUCCESSFUL ARE LIKELY TO TRY IT AGAIN AND AGAIN.

CREECH SAYS EVERYONE CAN GET THE BLUES. BUT ITS CLINICAL DEPRESSION THAT BRINGS THE INDIVIDUAL INTO A DANGER ZONE OF SORTS. SHE SAYS WHAT NEEDS TO HAPPEN IS FOR THE DEPRESSED PERSON TO REACH OUT AND ASK FOR HELP...OR FOR THOSE WHO KNOW THE PERSON TO TALK TO THEM AND PROBE THEM AS TO WHETHER ANYTHING IS WRONG.

THE 'WALK OUT OF DARKNESS' HAPPENS OCT 14TH IN HAMPTON PARK. ITS NOT A COMPETITIVE EVENT...BUT AN EVENT TO BRING PEOPLE TOGETHER AND SHOW SUPPORT AND OFFER TIME TO TALK.

VETERANS PORTRAIT PROJECT...APPRECIATING MILITARY SERVICE

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 14, 2018

GUEST: STACY PEARSALL...AIR FORCE VETERAN AND MILITARY PHOTOGRAPHER AND CREATOR OF THE VETERANS PORTRAIT PROJECT

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON PEARSALL'S HISTORY AND HER WORK HONORING VETERANS WITH PICTURES AND THEIR STORIES. SHE ENLISTED IN THE AIR FORCE AT THE AGE OF 17. SHE WAS TRAINED IN COMBAT...AND ALSO HAD THE ASSIGNMENT OF PHOTOGRAPHING THE BATTLES SHE WAS IN.

AFTER ABOUT 10 YEARS...SHE GOT OUT OF THE MILITARY....SUFFERING PTSD...PHYSICAL INJURIES (that earned her a bronze star) AND OTHER AFTER EFFECTS OF WAR. SEEKING HELP AT THE V-A SHE MET A 90 YEAR OLD VETERAN. THE TWO STARTED TALKING AND SHE REALIZED HER STORY WAS NOT THE ONLY ONE.

SHE STARTED OFFERING TO PHOTOGRAPH THESE VETS AND TELL THEIR STORY OF WHAT THEY EXPERIENCED. SHE GOES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY DOING THIS. SOCIAL MEDIA ENABLES HUNDREDS TO COME OUT...WANTING THEIR STORIES TOLD.

STACY TRAVELS WITH HER SERVICE DOG 'CHARLIE'. SHE IS ALSO A CONSULTANT AT THE CITADEL...AN AUTHOR....AND HAS A YOUTUBE SERIES.

HEAD FOR THE CURE....RESEARCHING BRAIN AND SPINE TUMORS

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 21, 2018

GUEST: DR DAVID CACHIA...MUSC NEUROSURGEON AND PART OF THE MUSC BRAIN AND SPINE TUMOR PROGRAM

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE RESEARCH UNDERWAY IN CHARLESTON TO BATTLE BRAIN TUMORS AND CANCERS. THERE ARE AT LEAST 120 BRAIN AND SPINE CANCERS. THE MOST COMMON IS THE TYPE THAT KILLED ARIZONA SENATOR JOHN MCCAINE AND THE SON OF FORMER VICE PRESIDENT JOE BIDEN. SUCH HIGH PROFILE DEATHS **DO** HELP DRAW ATTENTION TO THE NEED FOR A CURE FOR SUCH CANCERS.

BATTLING SUCH CANCERS IS A DIFFICULT AND DELICATE PROCESS...BECAUSE GREAT CARE MUST BE TAKEN WHEN CUTTING INTO THE BRAIN AND SPINAL CORD. THOSE AREAS ENABLE US TO MOVE AND THINK AND PROCESS INFORMATION AROUND US. THEREFORE....'CURES' WILL NOT COME EASILY. NOT ONLY IS TREATMENT EXPENSIVE AND 'IFFY'....BUT RESEARCH IS VERY EXPENSIVE.

IN FEBRUARY 2019....THE 'HEAD FOR THE CURE' 5K WALK AND RUN HAPPENS AT PALMETTO ISLANDS COUNTY PARK IN MT PLEASANT. THE AIM IS TO RAISE MONEY TO FUND NEEDED RESEARCH IN THE AREA OF BRAIN AND SPINAL CANCERS.

SURPRISINGLYMORE CHILDREN ARE BEING DIAGNOSED WITH BRAIN AND SPINAL CORD CANCERS AND TUMORS. LEUKEMIA USED TO BE NUMBER ONE CHILDHOOD CANCER. ITS NOT KNOWN WHY CANCERS DEVELOPMENT IN THE BRAIN...BUT IT IS HOPED THAT INCREASED RESEARCH MIGHT BE ABLE TO COME UP WITH AN ANSWER IN THE COMING YEARS.

THE NEW LEADERSHIP OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF EASTERN SOUTH CAROLINA

AIR DATE: OCTOBER 28, 2018

GUEST: DIANE FLANAGAN...THE NEW AND RECENTLY INSTALLED CEO OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF EASTERN SOUTH CAROLINA

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON FLANAGAN AND HER VISION FOR THE LOCAL REGIONAL GIRL SCOUTS ORGANIZATION. SHE IS A FORMER DIRECTOR AND MARKETING DIRECTOR FOR DELPHI AUTOMOTIVE SYSTEMS...AND WAS PART OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEXICO TECH CENTER IN MEXICO. SHE HAS ALSO BEEN INVOLVED WITH GIRL SCOUTS ORGANIZATIONS IN NEW MEXICO AND TEXAS.

SHE DISCUSSED THREE MAJOR KEYS OF THE NEW GIRL SCOUTS. THE ARE DISCOVER....CONNECT....AND TAKE ACTION. THAT'S THE MESSAGE THE SCOUTS ARE USING TO HELP MOLD TODAY'S GIRLS INTO THE LEADERS OF TOMORROW.

FLANAGAN SAYS HER EFFORTS WILL INCLUDE NOT ONLY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF GIRL SCOUTS...BUT ALSO INCREASING THE NUMBER OF GIRL SCOUT VOLUNTEERS. IT'S THE VOLUNTEERS THAT HELP FACILITATE THE ACTIVITIES FOR THE GIRLS.

EXTRA EFFORTS WILL BE PUT TOWARD STEERING GIRLS AND YOUNG WOMEN TO THE JOBS OF TOMORROW. THOSE JOBS ARE IN THE SO-CALLED STEM INDUSTRIES. FLANAGAN SAYS STEM COURSES NOT ONLY TEACH DISCIPLINE...BUT ALSO LOGIC.

LOW COUNTRY AUTISM FOUNDATION WORKING TO HELP FAMILIES

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 4, 2018

GUEST: SUSAN CALLAHAN WITH THE LOW COUNTRY AUTISM FOUNDATION AND ASSOCIATED WITH MUSC AUTISM TREATMENT

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE GROWING RATE OF KIDS BORN ON THE AUTISM SPECTRUM. A FEW YEARS AGO...1 IN 66 KIDS BORN WERE DIAGNOSED WITH AUTISM OF VARYING DEGREES. THE LATEST NUMBERS ARE 1 IN 58 BIRTHS OF KIDS WHO WILL BE FOUND TO HAVE ASPECTS OF AUTISM.

THE LOCL AUTISM FOUNDATION'S MISSION IS TO ENHANCE THE LIVES OF KIDS WITH AUTISM AND THEIR FAMILIES THRU TREATMENTS. SOMETIMES DRUGS ARE PRESCRIBED TO EASE ANXIETY. BUT MOST OF THE TREATMENTS ARE BEHAVIORAL MODIFICATION TRAINING. THAT IS...LEARNING HOW TO REACT AND RELATE IN THE REAL WORLD.

SUCH TREATMENTS ARE VERY EXPENSIVE AND CAN LAST FOR YEARS. ON NOVEMBER 11TH...LOW COUNTRY AUTISM FOUNDATION HOPES TO HAVE ANOTHER VERY SUCCESSFUL 'OYSTERS FOR AUTISM' FUNDRAISER AT BOWEN ISLAND FAMILY RESTAURANT. THOUSANDS HAVE BEEN RAISED DURING THIS EVENT TO FUND PROGRAMS THAT HELP KIDES FIT IN....AS THEY GROW UP.

NOVEMBER EFFORTS UNDERWAY AT THE CHARLESTON V-A TO
DIAGNOSE AND TREAT VETERANS FOR LUNG DISEASE

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 11, 2018

GUEST: DR NICOLE TANNER....PULMENARY DOCTOR AND LEADER
OF THE V-A'S LUNG CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE NEW EFFORT TO SCREEN VETERANS
FOR LUNG DISEASES. DR TANNER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT MAN OF
THOSE IN THE MILITARY...ESPECIALLY THE 'OLD TIMERS' HAVE
SMOKED FOR DECADES. BY THE AGE OF 70 MANY HAVE DEVELOPED
LUNG CANCERS AND OTHER AILMENTS CONNECTED TO SMOKING.

THE V-A IS LAUNCHING THIS NEW LUNG PROGRAM TO CO-INCIDE
WITH VETERANS DAY.

A NEW CONCERN AMONG DOCTORS AT THE V-A IS THE POPULARITY
OF VAPING AND THE USE OF ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES. THEY ARE
SAID TO BE POSITIVE IF ONE IS TRYING TO KICK THE HABIT. BUT
EXCHANGING TOBACCO FOR VAPING IS NOT SEEN AS POSITIVE.

AS FOR CURING LUNG CANCER....DR TANNER SAYS THE ONLY CURE
RIGHT NOW IS EARLY DETECTION. NEW SURGERIES ALSO HELP
HASTEN RECOVERING TIMES.

THE EFFORT WILL BE CONCENTRATED THRU OUT THE MONTH OF
NOVEMBER.

HELP ONE80 PLACE FILL ITS PANTRY WITH TURKEY AND A 20 DAY

GUEST: KATIE SMITH...MAJOR GIFTS OFFICER AT ONE80 PLACE
DOWNTOWN CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ANNUAL TURKEY AND A 20 EVENT. IT HAPPENS ALL DAY ON THE TUESDAY BEFORE THANKSGIVING. ONE80 PLACE WILL TAKE YOUR DONATED FROZEN TURKEY AND A CASH DONATION AT ITS WALNUT STREET LOCATION.

LAST YEAR...MORE THAN 40-THOUSAND DOLLARS WAS RAISED...AND ALMOST 600 TURKEYS DONATED. SOME OF THE TURKEYS ARE ROASTED FOR THANKSGIVING DAY. THE REST ARE STORED IN THE SHELTER'S HUGE WALK IN FREEZER AND USED THRU OUT THE YEAR. MONETARY DONATIONS GO TO BUY SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR THE 160 BED SHELTER.

ONE80 PLACE IS NOT JUST A SAFE PLACE FOR THE HOMELESS TO SLEEP. IT HELPS LOCATE HOUSING FOR THE HOMELESS....HELPS ITS CLIENTS GAIN THE SKILLS FOR JOBS...HELPS CLIENTS GET BACK ON THEIR FEET FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF A HOME.

SMITH SAYS THE FACE OF CHARLESTON'S HOMELESS IS NOT WHAT YOU'D IMAGINE. PEOPLE WHO LOOK LIKE THEY HAVE A PLACE TO LIVE CAN FALL ON HARD TIMES AND LOSE THEIR HOME OR APARTMENT. SMITH SAYS THEY ARE NOT ALL 'DRUNKS'.

ONE80 PLACE ALSO WORKS TO HELP WOMEN WITH CHILDREN AND VETERANS. ONE80 PLACE IS ALSO WORKING WITH THE CITY TO FIND OR BUILD MORE AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE CITY.

LIBERTY HILL LITERACY PROGRAM

GUESTS: ROBERT FLUDD AND COAKLEY HILTON...FOUNDERS OF LIBERTY HILL LITERACY PROGRAM IN NORTH CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CREATION OF AN AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR KIDS IN THE LIBERTY HILL COMMUNITY OF NORTH CHARLESTON. THE EFFORT BEGAN 10 YEARS AGO WITH ABOUT 20 STUDENTS. IT WAS AN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM THAT WORKED TO BRING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AGED KIDS' READING SKILLS UP TO STANDARDS.

OVER THE YEARS...IT HAS ATTRACTED EVEN MORE STUDENTS...AND OLDER STUDENTS. THE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM HAS ALSO BRANCHED OUT BEYOND TEACHING JUST READING SKILLS. THE SCHOOL ALSO HELPS STUDENTS LEARN SOCIAL SKILLS...MENTAL SKILLS...AND MATH SKILLS. ROBERT FLUDD LIKE TO BOAST THAT SOME OF THE FIRST STUDENTS WHO ATTENDED THE LIBERTY HILL LITERACY PROGRAM HAVE EARNED GRADES THAT ARE GOOD ENOUGH TO BE ADMITTED TO ACADEMIC MAGNET HIGH SCHOOL.

HE SAYS HE AND HILTON FELT THERE NEEDED TO BE A WAY TO BRING UP THE READING SKILLS OF STUDENTS IN LIBERTY HILL. SO THEY DECIDED TO START THE PROGRAM. BOTH SAYS ITS VERY IMPORTANT TO GIVE BACK TO THE GENERATION COMING UP. READING IN A SKILL THAT'S NEEDED FOR ANY KIND OF SUCCESS.

THE LIBERTY HILL LITERACY PROGRAM HAS RECENTLY BEEN AWARDED THE JEFFERSON AWARD. IT HONORS COMMUNITY SERVICE AND WAS STARTED BY JACQUELINE KENNEDY ONASIS IN 1972

THE RED CROSS IS ASKING FOR DONORS TO STEP UP DURING THE HOLIDAYS

GUEST: CUTHBERT LANGLEY...COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTOR FOR THE LOW COUNTRY AMERICAN RED CROSS

DISCUSSION CENTERED PRIMARILY ON THE SEASONAL DOWNTURN IN BLOOD DONATIONS DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON. THE NEED FOR BLOOD NEVER ENDS AS SURGERIES ARE STILL SCHEDULED DURING THE HOLIDAYS...PEOPLE ARE RECOVERING FROM CANCER TREATMENT EVERY DAY OF THE YEAR....SICKLE CELL ANEMIA PATIENTS CONTINUE TO NEED BLOOD EVERY DAY...ALL YEAR LONG.

BUT THIS IS THE TIME OF YEAR DONATIONS DROP. LANGLEY SAYS PEOPLE GET BUSIER THIS TIME OF YEAR...PEOPLE TAKE VACATIONS THRU OUT DECEMBER. STILL...THE RED CROSS IS OUT IN THE COMMUNITY TRYING TO ENTICE RESIDENTS TO SPEND 45 MINUTES TO DONATE A PINT OF BLOOD.

PLATELETS TAKE ALITTLE LONGER TO DONATE...BUT THEY ARE NEEDED BY SOME NEWBORNS....CANCER AND BURN VICTIMS.

BLOOD DONATIONS ARE ESSENTIAL IN THE COMMUNITY. HARD TO BELIEVE THAT 38% OF THE POPULATION IS ELIGIBLE TO DONATE. BUT ONLY 5% OF THOSE ACTUALLY DO. PLEASE DONATE BLOOD TODAY.

HOW TO SPEND WISELY DURING THE HOLIDAYS AND STAY OUT OF FINANCIAL TROUBLE

AIR DATE: DECEMBER 9, 2018

GUEST: DOROTHEA BERNIQUE...FOUNDER OF A NON PROFIT KNOWN AS 'INCREASING HOPE'...OFFERING CLASSES FOR THOSE WHO WANT TO LEARN HOW TO RESPONSIBLY HANDLE THEIR MONEY AND PLAN FOR THE FUTURE

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON HOW TO USE YOUR MONEY TO YOUR HIGHEST ADVANTAGE. MANY OF US GO OUT INTO THE WORLD...EARN A PAYCHECK...AND YET HAVE NO IDEA HOW TO SPEND AND SAVE MONEY RESPONSIBLY.
