Several weeks ago, HISD's Superintendent Mike Miles had said between 500 to 600 jobs would be cut that were vacant or filled and last night it was confirmed that more than 2,000 positions have been eliminated. Miles says they mainly eliminated vacant roles - 1,675 to be precise. He shared that the 672 people that did have their roles eliminated altogether have the opportunity to apply for open roles and move within the district.
