1	PFD Filing	Local News	1/3/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Filing period for the 2020 permanent fund dividend is now open until March 31. The process of how to apply and other facts about the dividend was given.
2	Telephone Scam	Local News	1/6/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	2 minutes	Fairbanks Police Department is warning residents of a scam caller who has been posing as a Fairbanks police officer to swindle money from people.
3	Food Recall	Local News	1/6/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	3 minutes	Due to a mislabeling error, Chocolate Sea Salt Probiotic Granola is being recalled as walnuts were not mentioned in the ingredient list. An e-mail address was given for those who would like a replacement of the granola.
4	Beware of Moose	Local News	1/14/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	6 minutes	People were warned to be extra cautious around moose during the winter. They are cold and hungry and have shorter fuses. Also reminded not to feed the moose and the problems that could arise if done. Also described moose body language so listeners can tell if a moose is agitated.
5	Blood Donations	Local News	1/16/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	5 minutes	The Blood Bank of Alaska is encouraging new and existing donors to visit their local blood center to make a donation. During cold weather there is a decrease in donations and blood only lasts 42 days on the shelf.

6	Telephone Scam	Local News	1/22/20 7:00 am & noon	5 minutes	Alaska's Attorney General is issuing a warning about a new round of scams targeting Alaskans in which the caller pretends to be from the Social Security Administration. More information given as to how to recognize the scam, and a phone number was given to report scams
7	China Evacuation	Local News	1/27/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	5 minutes	Informing the public that a plane evacuating US Citizens from China will be landing in Anchorage. Informs the public about the safety precautions that are in place to ensure that the virus will not spread to residents in Alaska.
8	Avalanches	Local News	2/6/20 7:00 am & noon	7 minutes	Information about the danger of avalanches was given. Avalanches can happen anywhere conditions are right, even on creek banks, and from house roofs. Information given about where to find avalanche forecasts and about the Alaska Avalanche School for those wanting to be more informed.
9	Road Kills	Local News	2/12/20 7:00 am & noon	5 minutes	Information was given on what to do and what not to do when a moose is hit by a car.
10	Electric bills and Meter mix-ups	Local News	2/21/20 7:00 am & noon	10 minutes	Listeners were encouraged to do a breaker check if they live in a building with multiple meter readers. Meter mix-ups are rare, but can happen as it did to the one the news story was about. It is the customers responsibility to provide the correct meter number.
11	Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend	Local News	2/26/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	10 minutes	Fairbanks Democratic Rep. Adam Wool has introduced a bill that would pay out smaller annual dividends but put additional money from the permanent fund earnings reserve toward the University of Alaska and individual communities across the state. A percentage listing of where the funds would go was given.

12	Coronavirus Testing	Local News	3/02/20 7:00 am & noon	5 minutes	Alaska State public health laboratories now have the ability to test for the coronavirus. Alaska has had no cases as of yet. If a case shows up, personal health information will be kept confidential, but the public will be notified that there has been a positive case. Phone numbers were given for providers.
13	Coronavirus and Airports	Local News	3/06/20 7:00 am & noon	6 minutes	Informs the public as to how the airports are taking extra steps to disinfect public and employee spaces. Also reminds the listeners to wash hands frequently and use the hand sanitizers.
14	Land Auction Sale	Local News	3/09/20 7:00 am & noon	3 minutes	Alaskans have an opportunity to buy land from the Department of Natural Resources. This land is remote and road accessible. Information was given on how to do the bidding and where to find more information.
15	Coronavirus, University of Alaska and public schools	Local News	3/12/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	12 minutes	The University of Alaska laid out steps to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus. All courses will be online, spring break extended for one week, students are asked to move out of the dorm. Also talked of how the public schools in Fairbanks and Anchorage were extending their spring break. Alaska's first case of coronavirus was announced. Informed the public of the symptoms of COVID-19 and that people should stay home and call health care provider if sick.
16	Coronavirus and State Troopers	Local News	3/16/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Informs the public how the State Troopers are taking additional steps to protect their officers by using gloves, masks, safety glasses and aprons when in contact with someone who may be sick. If a listener comes in contact with a state trooper while sick, you should let them know. Practice good hygiene and stay at home if not well.
17	Coronavirus and Governor mandates	Local News	3/18/20 7:00 am & noon	2 minutes	All dine in services are suspended statewide – carry out or drive through only. Fourteen day self quarantine is required for those who have traveled outside.

18	Blood Donations	Local News	3/19/20 7:00 am & noon	2 minutes	The Blood Bank of Alaska need 700 donations in the next few weeks. There is a specific need for O-positive and O-negative. Because of the coronavirus, many people are not coming in donating making the deficit in blood even greater. Information on how to schedule appointments was given.
19	Homeschooling	Local News	3/23/20 7:00 am & noon	5 minutes	Information given about homeschooling during the coronavirus, how to begin, websites to check out, facebook groups, and various tips and ideas.
20	Health Mandates 11 and 12	Local News	3/30/20 7:00 am & noon	5 minutes	There are two new health mandates in Alaska. All persons not engaged in essential services are mandated to remain at their place of residence and practice social distancing (six feet or more) when outside. All in-state travel between communities is prohibited unless travel is to support critical infrastructure or for critical personal needs. A website was also given with information on how to keep yourself and your family healthy.
