<b>1</b>	Ford Recall	Local News	10/2/20 7:00 am & noon	2 minutes	Ford is recalling several 2020 vehicles due to a poor electrical connection. Dealers will replace the rear view camera at no cost to the owners. The recall is expected to start November 7 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>2</b>	At Home COVID Tests	Local News	10/5/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Safeway pharmacies in Alaska are now offering at-home COVID-19 test kits. Information was given as to the cost and how the test works.
<b>3</b>	Exposure to Toxic Substances	Local News	10/6/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Warning that hand sanitizers containing methanol should not be used. Symptoms to methanol exposure were listed. Also warned that children's exposure to bleach has also increased during the pandemic.
<b>4</b>	Absentee Voting	Local News	10/13/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	2 minutes	Alaska voters who wish to vote absentee will not need to turn in a witness signature with their ballot due to the COVID-19 pandemic the court system decided last week. However, the instructions on the already-printed ballots will remain the same as in past years.
<b>5</b>	Vehicles alongside the road	Local News	10/21/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	3 minutes	After a bait trailer placed on the side of the road by the State Troopers went missing, Alaska State Troopers encourage the public not to assume property left along roadways are abandoned. Do not take if you are not the owner, or do not have permission.

<b>6</b>	Rapid-response COVID-19 Tests	Local News	10/27/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	A total of 220,000 rapid response COVID-19 tests will soon be en route to Alaska. They will be for students, teachers, nursing homes, critical infrastructure and other priorities as the governor sees fit.
<b>7</b>	Road Plowing	Local News	10/27/20 7:00 am & noon	6 minutes	Informed the public that roads are plowed by priority with the highways and expressways being plowed while it is still snowing. After the storm, priority will shift to level 2 roads – the main city streets. After that will be the lower traffic roads and the small neighborhood routes.
<b>8</b>	Voting	Local News	10/27/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	A news article of a 103 year old voter, encouraging others about the importance of voting and being informed.
<b>9</b>	Winter Storm	Local News	11/6/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	8 minutes	After a winter storm with a significant snowfall, Alaskans were cautioned to limit travel if possible, informed about the plowing of roadways, warned about possible power outages, and that deliveries down the Parks Highway would not happen on Monday.
<b>10</b>	Disaster Declaration	Local News	11/10/20 7:00 am & noon	2 minutes	A new 30 day disaster declaration goes into effect Nov 16 as COVID-19 case numbers and hospitalizations continue to rise in Alaska.
<b>11</b>	Emergency Declaration	Local News	11/12/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	6 minutes	Gov. Mike Donleavy issued an emergency message today asking Alaskans to take immediate action to slow the spread of the virus. People should work from home if possible. Fairbanks North Star Borough school system moving to full remote learning, and other information was also given.
<b>12</b>	Technical Support Scam	Local News	11/18/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	4 minutes	The FBI wants Alaskans to be wary of callers claiming to provide technical support for the computers or online accounts. Lists tips for avoiding these scams and also provided a phone number for anyone who believes they've been a victim of fraud.

<b>13</b>	Holiday Travel	Local News	11/24/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	4 minutes	With the increase in holiday travel, information was given about the safety of flying during the pandemic. The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention officials strongly discourage travel for the holidays.
<b>14</b>	Fire Prevention	Local News	11/25/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Gave fire statistics and several tips on how to prevent fires for if you smoke, when you cook, and when using a space heater.
<b>15</b>	COVID Vaccines	Local News	11/26/20 7:00 am & noon	3 minutes	Information about when people can start expecting the COVID Vaccine to arrive in Alaska, who will receive it first. Also talked about how they want to keep the cost low so everyone will be able to receive one.
<b>16</b>	Ice Fishing	Local News	12/3/20 7:00 am & noon	4 minutes	Gave information on ice fishing, and lakes in Alaska that are stocked with fish. Also gave a website for people to go to for more information on stocked lakes throughout the state.
<b>17</b>	Stolen Voter Information	Local News	12/3/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	5 minutes	Information about voter information being stolen from 113,000 Alaskans. Integrity of the election was not compromised. A hotline has been created for people to call with questions and to check if their information has been compromised.
<b>18</b>	Pearl Harbor Day	Local News	12/7/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	5 minutes	Information about Pearl Harbor day and the importance of remembering it. Also talked about the effect of World War II on Alaska and how it helped Alaska become a state.
<b>19</b>	National Weather Service	Local News	12/11/20 7:00 am & noon	2 minutes	The National Weather Service will be replacing their radar viewer webpage with a new, more feature rich design that improves usability while still providing the public access the data. Information about the data was given, and how a person can use it. The webpage address was also given.
<b>20</b>	Fire Safety at Christmastime	Local News	12/11/20 6:00 pm & 10:00 pm	4 minutes	Information about how to be fire safe when using a real tree for Christmas, candles, and Christmas lights.
