Re: Election of Retransmission Consent

Dear Ms. Franklin and Mr. Crippen:

This letter is in response to your October 7, 2020 letter notifying Fox Television Stations, LLC (“FTS”) that Delcom Telecommunications LLC dba Faslite Entertainment (“Operator”) intends to begin providing cable television service in the Orlando, FL DMA. Television stations WOFL and WRBW, Orlando, FL (“Stations”), elect retransmission consent with respect to retransmission of their broadcast signals by Operator. This election is for any headend located in or around any and all communities serving the Orlando DMA.

Accordingly, the Stations hereby notify Operator that, pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “ACT”), and Section 76.64(f)(2) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (the “Rules”), the Stations elect to assert their rights under section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Act and Section 76.64(a) of the Rules to require that Operator obtain Stations’ express consent before retransmitting its signal (which consent is not granted herein). This election of retransmission consent is for the remainder of this election cycle ending on December 31, 2020 and for the next election cycle through December 31, 2023.

To the extent that Operator does not qualify as an “MVPD” as defined by the FCC as of the date hereof, FTS has no obligation to provide Operator with a notice of a must-carry or retransmission consent election and has no obligation to negotiate in good faith. Nothing contained herein shall be allowed to constitute a waiver of, or forbearance from the exercise of, any of FTS’s rights and remedies.
