City of McAllen to Host Inaugural Citizens' Code Academy

The City of McAllen Environmental Health & Code Enforcement Department is looking for a few good citizens to help clean up their neighborhood. The Citizens Code Academy seeks to promote clean and safe neighborhoods through community empowerment and action by creating and maintaining strong partnerships between citizens' organizations and Code Compliance Services.

The Academy is three weeks long and attendees will learn about various subjects such as the department's organizational structure, premise violations, substandard structures, the 3-1-1 app overview, community tool shed, community partnerships, common code violations, nuisance abatement, zoning and vector control.
