During the last quarter, WPIE ascertained that **Recreation & Community Events are of major interest in our community.**

In an effort to broadcast responsive programming to deal with these issues, WPIE took the following action during the 1st Broadcast Quarter of 2019:

WPIE broadcast a segment of its local talk sports talk show, *Between the Lines*, discussing The Kraft Hockeyville contest, giving local arenas and ice rink the chance to upgrade its facility with a \$150,000 donation. Hosts Nick Karski and Mark Shelley discussed the contesting and urged listeners to log on to the contest website and vote for Ithaca's Cass Park.

The ice rink is open to the local community for skating during the winter and is also set this year to serve as the home rink for the Ithaca High School Boys & Girls Hockey teams. Built in 1972, the facility at Cass Park is the last remaining open-air ice rink in New York State.
