#### Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- 1. **Clean Technology:** Automakers are working hard to provide clean and natural energy in their newer vehicles. As it stands, Michigan currently has 10,620 electric vehicles, according to Stacker, landing us at number 21 overall for clean energy.
- 2. **Higher Education**: Student loan debt currently resides at \$1.7 billion across the United States. Michigan alone, makes up 13.7% of that debt alone according to MLive. Making Michigan the seventh highest in the nation for student debt.
- 3. **Mental Health**: Millions of people in the United States struggle with sleep. According to Sleepopolis, Michigan residents occur 31 hours of sleep debt. Higher than the national average of 30.6 hours.
- 4. **Debt**: Attending a four-year college for an undergraduate is quickly getting expensive in the U.S. some students are spending over \$110,000 for a four-year undergraduate. To get a four-year undergraduate at one Michigan university, you could be spending \$208,392 to be a full-time student.
- 5. **Labor Rights**: With the ongoing issues with the threat of a rail strike, most of America could've seen a major shutdown. Michigan alone heavily relies on the rail system. In 2021, Michigan had 540,000 employees involved in a union according to the BLS. Those union members accounted for 13% of the working industry in Michigan.
