The United States Congress in 1994, acknowledged that there are immigrants who are victims of abusers and perpetrators of domestic violence offenses. They also recognized that there are victims of human trafficking, and sexual assault. These abusers often threaten their victims with deportation. To stop these abusers use of

immigration to promote its abuse or criminal activity, Congress created the immigration law for victims of such abuse. This law is called "Act of Violence Against Women" VAWA woman or child whose abusive husbands or parents are US citizens or legal permanent residents can make a "request for oneself" low VAWA. Elderly victims

abused by their US citizen children over 21 years old can also make this request. Victims of Human Trafficking: T-Visa A person is a victim of human trafficking if their presence in the US It is due to force,

fraud or threats and are forced to provide labor, services, or sex work. As a victim of human trafficking, they may be eligible for the visa Visa T. T was created to helpvictims and to not be afraid of reporting to the authorities and assist in helping incases against human traffickers.
