By the year 2050, 15 million people in the U.S. could have this degenerative, incurable disorder. ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE FACTS

- It is estimated that five million people in the U.S. have Alzheimer's disease. One in eight people age 65 and older and nearly one out of two over age 85 may be affected. The number could rise to over 15 million by 2050.
- On average, a person with Alzheimer's disease lives for 8 to 10 years after diagnosis, but one can live for up to 20 years. Although progression may be slowed by current drug therapies, it is a terminal and incurable disease.
- The number of caregivers will rapidly increase as the population ages and the number of people with Alzheimer's disease grows.
- As Alzheimer's disease progresses, patients require 24-hour care.
- Approximately 70% of Americans with Alzheimer's disease live at home, where families care for them.
- The yearly cost of caring for one Alzheimer's patient is between \$18,400 and \$36,132 depending on how advanced the disease is. The health care expenses and lost wages for patients and caregivers are thought to be \$100 billion annually.


