10/16/2020 at 08:00 am to 10:00 am...2 hours...Catholic Connection. The host is Teresa Tomeo. Teresa talked about a famous woman, Stevie Nicks, who had an abortion. parked in the neighbors drive way. He wondered how he got there so quickly. The man was a really skinny guy who didn't have enough muscle power to pull the mower out. But that is what he did. He walked over to the ditch and pulled the mower out. He commented that he didn't know if he would be around if it happened again and then he left. Was this God's hand or was the man stronger than he looked?

Dr. Ray talked about how parents want their children to understand their feelings and thoughts on whatever is happening in their family. Parents have to realize that they were brought up in a culture that has changed and so their children aren't going to understand where they are coming from. Dr. Ray talked about repressed memory syndrome. A caller talked about a woman who was sexually abused from a small child until she was ten years old. She lived in this sexual trauma environment with no support or love. When her mother passed away her memory of this trauma started coming to mind. Her dad had already passed away. In her early sixties, she went into therapy and has been there for four years. The therapy hasn't helped much. The caller says she doesn't have empathy for others and doesn't know what to do for them when placed in these situations. The caller said she looks like a deer in head lights. Dr. Ray wonders why the therapy hasn't made some improvement in her.

Dr. Ray started his hour by talking about our culture, the way people are living make it look like fathers don't matter. This is what Dr. Ray has to say about this matter. Father's matter, 90% of homeless and run away children are from fatherless homes.

71% of pregnant teenagers lack a father figure. 63% of youth suicides are from fatherless homes. 71% of high school drop outs come from fatherless homes. 70% of juveniles in state operated institutions have no father. Fatherless boys and girls are twice as likely to drop out of high school and end up in jail. Loving father's are really important in a child's life. These are the words of Dr. Ray.

Dr. Ray says that we are not coming back to normal. Our population is becoming germaphobic. He feels the virus will always be here. Our immune systems are supposed to protect us from the virus. People won't go to restaurants anymore. Plastic shields will always be up, so you talk through plastic. Our population is petrified of getting the virus. He heard a teacher talk about her students and she has three or four year old children who panic because their masks slipped while on the faces and they wondered if they were going to die.
