The list of issues were accumulated from County, City and State Government officials as well as other major members of the Las Vegas broadcast community with whom we have partnered on several important public service projects. KSNE-FM employees in contact with business and community leaders routinely ask for input on what those individuals consider to be the priority needs and interests of our community. That information is forwarded to the programming staff of the radio station. Programming is targeted to address these issues dealing with the community and their families.

One of the primary vehicles for the discussion of community concerns over KSNE-FM is "Observations with Bob Fisher". "Observations" is an interview program featuring prominent Nevadans in government, business, education and tourism. "Observations" airs on Sunday mornings from 7 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.

Local issues are also addressed by way of traffic reports, weather reports and through the use of public service announcements (PSA's). The radio station also brings issues to the forefront by participating in local charity events and running promotional projects, which heighten community involvement. KSNE broadcasts live announcements encouraging listeners and organizations to send us information so we can publicize their events and activities via PSA's and our online Community Calendar.

KSNE's Public Service programming include 30 minutes of original, locally produced Public Service programming with "Observations," traffic reports of an accumulative 60 minutes per week, and numerous PSA's.

Observations, 4th Quarter 2013

Hosted by Bob Fisher, President of the Nevada Broadcasters Association, "Observations" is a program that features those who have a prominent impact on the State of Nevada in terms of the economy, education, tourism, and government, or those community leaders who can address issues/needs affecting the Las Vegas area. The program airs Sunday mornings at 7 a.m.
