The deadly school shooting at Marjorie Douglas HS in Florida again provokes demands for answers. Would anyone be willing to seriously consider a more liberal policy to restrict legal gun usage if someone has been ruled to have a mental illness? Polls have suggested a majority of Americans might be willing to accept some restrictions in the form of eliminating “bump stocks” or mechanisms that allow for the firing of many rounds. Would you accept that? Restrictions on the number of rounds to prevent mass shootings? Why did Trump have few specifics on ways to curb such attacks? Does FL Gov. Rick Scott have a point about taking guns out of the hands of the mentally ill? The US Senate has a proposal for immigration reform. And accepts nothing less. The Republicans seem to want restrictions to bump stocks, age limits for buying guns and a possible end to Gun Free Zones at schools.
