Mitten News stations WJML, WJNL, WHAK and W266CS changed format from News/Talk to Sports on May 3, 2021. Format and Programming mirrors WGRY-FM 101.1.

FRONTLINES OF FREEDOM:

WGRY, WJML, WJNL, WHAK and W266CS air the program Frontlines of Freedom from 7A-9A every Sunday. The program is a military news and talk radio show designed to address and discuss the most pressing issues facing our armed forces, veterans and their families.

Frontlines of Freedom is hosted by Lt. Col. Denny Gillem, US Army (Retired), a west point graduate and highly decorated combat veteran who also served as a Mideast War Planner during his 22 years on active duty.
