

WTKY-AM PUBLIC ISSUES FOR 1st QUARTER 2021

We at WTKY-AM take our public service programming seriously. We interview a variety of guests that are involved, and make up our community. We air our program each Monday morning from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. We rebroadcast that same program each Monday evening from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the listeners that may have missed the morning broadcast.

In addition to the highlighted guests listed below, we have additional guests on the program that might have information not as critical as our main guests, but community information, just the same. Such additional guests include quilting clubs, art clubs, athletic hall of fame, and much, much, more.

We also have our Community Calendar that airs Monday through Saturday, sometime between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. The length of the program varies because the items listed are brief, and added and deleted daily.

Please note that the health orders for the current COVID crisis have impacted the availability of guests, making interviews much shorter, and in some weeks, impossible. In lieu of live guests, the stations have decided to highlight local musical artists from the area.

1.4.21 Host Randy Kerr welcomes in the New Year to Monroe County. Guest Kevin Lions from the extension office discusses the weather, and how some of the coldness is good for the farmers because it keeps the insects down in the summer. Also discussed is the live stock situation in the county, and general management of cows. (50 minutes)

1.11.21 Host Randy Kerr discusses with guest Larry Miller the general situation at the hospital, and what is happening with the COVID numbers. Also discussed is COVID update in the county, and reminders to socially distance and wear a mask. Also discussed is the status of the Heart Beat Café, which is now open for 50% capacity. Also discussed are dietary supplements that are very popular, and how to get those same vitamins in foods that you eat. (55 minutes)

2.8.21 Host Randy Kerr discusses the recent cold snap with guest Bobby Gentry, who also discusses local fishing. Guest talks about their various local species of fish, and the best time of year to catch each. Also discussed is how popular fishing is in the area, and how many tourists the tri-county area gets due to the good fishing. Bobby also works for the school board, and fishing is really important to a lot of the kids. (50 minutes)

2.22.21 Host Randy Kerr discusses 4H with Susan Turner and Charter Harnik, including the tagging events that are coming up. All the money from the tag event is split between 4H, FFA and Department of Agriculture. Fortunately, COVID is getting better in the area, so many of the restrictions that were impacting 4H are easing. They are looking forward to several events this year, that will be in person. Also discussed are favorite pie recipes. (55 minutes)

3.8.21 Host Randy Kerr discusses this day in history with guest and new owner, Jamie Keeton, including international woman's day, and the first stock car race in Daytona. (30 minutes). Then

guest Larry Miller discusses local COVID situation, and provides an overview of local events. (25 minutes)

3.22.21 Host Randy Kerr discusses healthy eating, including yogurt and granola and how important they are for gut health. Also discussed is upcoming Easter events slated for Monroe County. (20 minutes) Guest Sheila rush discusses the latest news from Old Mulkey, including the return of tourists, and grants that she's applying for. (35 minutes)
