HOW TREATED: Live Read  
TITLE: Property Tax Bond

DESCRIPTION: Listeners were provided with tips about how to build a survival kit in case of a natural disaster.

HOW TREATED: PSA  
TITLE: Gun Curiosity: "Gunfight"

TYPE: Information  
DESCRIPTION: In this PSA, two kids are playing and using pretend lasers to shoot at each other. After the fight is over, the listener is reminded that that while pretend guns are fine, real guns should be locked away and kept out of children's hands.

TITLE: Gun Curiosity: "Childish Curiosity"

DURATION: 0:30  
TYPE: Information  
DESCRIPTION: A young boy asks a variety of questions demonstrating that he is curious about the world. His string of questions ends with him asking what a gun does followed by the sound of a gun cocking. The listener is encouraged to keep guns locked away and out of the reach of children.

TITLE: Pest Control

TYPE: Information  
DESCRIPTION: A series of people describe symptoms such as rashes and asthma flare-ups and realize that a tick or a roach problem. It ends with their website URL, encouraging us to find out more about pests and the diseases they spread.

TITLE: ADHD Awareness

TYPE: Information  
DESCRIPTION: The listener is provided some telltale signs of ADHD, such as difficulty paying attention and sitting still, and informs us that most kids with ADHD also have

another mental disorder as well. Finally, a website is given at the end to help those who may have questions or wish to seek treatment.

HOW TREATED: PSA  
TITLE: Noxious Weeds  
DATE: 06/20/2022 – 06/30/2022  
DURATION: 0:30  
TYPE: Information  
DESCRIPTION: A narrator informs about the dangers of various seemingly harmless weeds. They're not just unsightly but can be very harmful to a healthy lawn and thus need to be exterminated quickly.
