Each station that re-aired on October 24, 2015, the episode of "Saturday Night Live" featuring an appearance by former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, which originally aired on October 3, 2015, should complete the following notice by (1) choosing the feed aired by the station, (2) inserting the appropriate call sign and community of license in the text, and (3) uploading a copy of the notice to the online political file maintained for public inspection by the station <u>no later than noon local time on</u> <u>Monday, October 26</u>. Please let Affiliate Relations know promptly if your station receives a demand for equal time from any of the other candidates.

Notice Required by Section 73.1943 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission:

Former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, a candidate for the Democratic nomination for President in the 2016 national election, appeared without charge on NBC's re-airing of the October 3, 2015, episode of "Saturday Night Live" for a total period of 3:12 (three minutes and twelve seconds) commencing at 11:52:56 PM EDT on October 24 and ending at 12:01:36 AM EDT on October 25, 2015. Station WFMJ, Youngstown Ohio, is affiliated with the NBC Television Network and broadcast the episode of "Saturday Night Live," including the segments in which Secretary Clinton appeared, on October 24, 2015.
