use of two small arms annexes in NLV that are controlled by Nellis. The Air Force is reviewing the property and preparing to clean up munitions and other contaminants in the soil and finding a public use.

She is a member of Nation of Patriots, a national non-profit that raises money for veterans and their families who are in need of financial assistance. She says 100 percent of the funds go to veterans — all the members are volunteers. As the riders' cross state lines, the flag was passed on to new riders, and carried to the next state.
