Re: Election of Retransmission Consent (KSDK, St. Louis, MO)

## Dear Adam:

I write regarding your e-mail dated September 22, 2020, in which you state that Computer Techniques, Inc. dba CTI Fiber ("Operator") intends to commence cable television service in Montgomery County, Illinois, located in the St. Louis Designated Market Area (the "St. Louis DMA"), and wishes to retransmit the signal of television station KSDK, St. Louis, Missouri ("KSDK"), over Operator's proposed cable system (the "Montgomery County System"). KSDK is licensed to Multimedia KSDK, LLC ("Licensee"), a wholly owned subsidiary of TEGNA Inc.

TEGNA, on behalf of Licensee, hereby gives notice to Operator that Licensee elects retransmission consent status for KSDK pursuant to Section 325(b)(3)(B) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64(h) and (k) of the FCC's rules. This election applies to the Montgomery County System as well as any other distribution systems that you or your affiliated entities own, operate, or manage. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 325(b)(1)(A) of the Communications Act and Section 76.64(a) of the FCC's rules, KSDK's broadcast signals may not be carried on the Montgomery County System or other distribution systems that you own, operate, or manage without Licensee's express written consent pursuant to a retransmission consent agreement. This election of retransmission consent applies both for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020, and for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023.
