## **January 2024**

We conducted a live on-air interview with representatives from the Oklahoma Dept Of Veterans Affairs Muskogee Benefits Office to discuss a “Road Trip” event a mobile VA Claims Clinic. Held at the Greenwood Cultural Center in Tulsa, offering screening for toxic exposure, enrollment in healthcare and how to file a service connection claim. The event took place from 9am-4pm.

## **February 2024**

We conducted a live on-air interview with Jeanetta Williams with Youth Services of Tulsa, that helps with a wide array of innovative and proven programs focused on counseling, runaway and homeless youth, delinquency prevention and youth development. She discussed National Safe Place Week Awareness and Call for volunteers. There are 300 sites in the Tulsa area providing a Safe Place in every neighborhood for youth to seek help in times of crisis. Community partners included Quick Trip, EMSA, Tulsa Fire Dept, MedWise, Tulsa Transit, Tulsa Glassblowing School and Tulsa City-County Libraries.

## **March 2024**

We conducted a live on-air interview with representatives putting on the free community event “Unity In The Community”. The event had free food, live music and guest speakers. An event designed to promote positivity, inspiration and peace in the community!
