**1. PROMOTE MIRACLE FARMS ORGANIZATION AND PROGRAMS THEY OFFER
FOLLOWING GOD’S LEADERSHIP**

Program Title: “Miracle Farm”

Description: KTTX communicated to parents about programs Miracle Farm offers to at-risk teenage boys who want to change their lives for the better. KTTX interviewed Director of Development Gena Wilimitis of Miracle Farm, where she discussed the benefits of the program and how the young men grow and graduate from each level and with that they gain more responsibilities. She explained the benefits and success rate from young men who graduated this program and how successful they are in life.

2. SUPPORT LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNITY FACILITY

Program Title: “Brenham Fireman’s Fiesta”

Description: KTTX promoted the annual Brenham Fireman’s Fiesta on Saturday, August 14th at the Fireman’s Training Center in Brenham. The event raised funds for the Brenham Fire Department for rescue supplies, training, as well as maintenance for the Brenham Fireman’s Training Center. KTTX promoted the event with recorded promotional ads, live DJ liners, interview during the morning show, and a live broadcast during the event.

Time Broadcast: Advance promotional ads and DJ liners aired in all dayparts; Interview aired 6:00 – 10:00 a.m. Remote aired 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Dates Broadcast: Promotional ads and live liners were broadcast 7/5 - 8/14; Interviews aired 8/10 and broadcast aired 8/14.

3. PROMOTE LOCAL BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB AND PROGRAMS THEY OFFER STUDENTS

Program Title: "Boys and Girls Club of Washington County"

Description: KTTX communicated to parents and students about opportunities for activities and education during the summer. KTTX interviewed Executive Director Stephanie Wehring of the Boys and Girls Club of Washington County, where she discussed what benefits children had from joining the club. She explained what the club was doing to help children, even if they could not come in to the facility due to the pandemic. KTTX interviewed Wehring during the morning show about Fall Registration.

Program Title: City of Brenham's "Guns & Hoses Blood Drive"

Description: KTTX promoted the annual blood drive held by the City of Brenham Fire and Police Departments. The Brenham Fire Department and the Brenham Police Department held their annual blood drive competition on Friday, August 20th and Saturday, August 21st at the Brenham Fireman's Training Center. KTTX provided a live remote broadcast from the blood drive on Saturday, August 21st. Dates Broadcast: Promotional ads and DJ liners aired 7/19 – 8/21; Interview aired 8/10; Remote broadcast aired 8/21.
