The Joseph Smith Papers: A Television Series, is a program that explains the ambitious effort to compile, transcribe, edit and present the papers of, by and directly related to LDS Prophet Joseph Smith, and examines his life and the events surrounding the content of those papers.

It has been said that Joseph Smith remains the most unstudied genius of American religious history. Some have characterized the future publication of the papers as the most important collection of written material since the advent of LDS scripture.

Larry H. Miller has been a fervent supporter of the project and was key to providing resources that put the project on firm financial footing. "Joseph Smith is an important historical and spiritual figure in United States history and having the opportunity to contribute to a project of this magnitude is not only exciting, but leaves me with the belief that I am helping to tell a story that people should hear," said Miller.

The project is under the administration of the Family and Church Historical Department of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. The program features a fascinating peek into how the papers are being compiled and some insightful analysis on the life and times of Joseph Smith. The series contains weekly half-hour shows featuring remarkable interviews and lectures of historians contributing to the Joseph Smith Papers Project. Included are preeminent scholars Dean C. Jessee, Richard L. Bushman, Ronald K. Esplin, Ronald O. Barney, Richard L. Anderson, Larry C. Porter, Milton V. Backman, and Gordon Madsen.

About *The Joseph Smith Papers*

The Joseph Smith Papers will be a comprehensive edition of extant Joseph Smith documents featuring complete and accurate transcriptions with both textual and contextual annotation. This will constitute an essential resource for serious students of the life and work of Joseph Smith, early Mormonism, and nineteenth-century American religion. For the first time, all of Joseph Smith's surviving papers, which include many of the foundational documents of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, will be easily accessible in one place.

The Joseph Smith Papers Project is not a "documentary history" project comprising all important documents relating to Joseph Smith. Instead, it is a "papers" project that will publish, according to accepted scholarly and documentary editing standards, documents created by Joseph Smith or by staff whose work he directed. The project also includes papers received and "owned" by his office. These key documents include, especially, the diaries, outgoing and incoming correspondence, revelations, contemporary reports of discourses, editorials, and notices.
