

NOAA is looking to pass a law that could end the lobster industry in Maine and would cripple our economy.

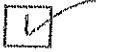
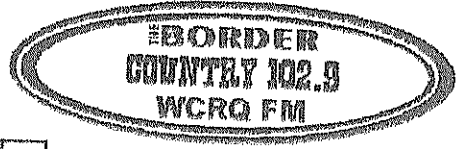
The government says the lobster industry is threatening right whales and that they are on the endangered species list.



We Spoke with Executive Director of Volunteer Services for Downeast hospice Volunteers Barbara Barnett.

This interview helps to Inform our listeners about the free classes being offered by Downeast Hospice Volunteers.

Volunteers provide an important service to our community.

Downeast Hospice Volunteers assist with elderly care in Washington county.

**I do get concerned about people who take the training and do not get a hospice client assignment for a very long time. I don't want any of you to lose heart. The right client in an area that is not too far to travel to, will come along.

If someone takes the training and feels that they want to postpone taking a client - this is perfectly fine. If you are seasonal, you can be a hospice volunteer when you are here in Washington County & a hospice volunteer where you spend your winters, if you choose to do so.

Volunteers can make their own schedules when working with a family. Your time is very flexible. We always remind hospice volunteers not offer more than they can comfortably provide.

Lupe, I would like to read the following if there is time:

**Our trainings are fairly informal. It's an opportunity to see how a group of people who do not know each other will get along. After all, every home you go into, each hospice story you get to be involved with will be unique and special. Hospice volunteers are always confidential, patient, kind and compassionate. You will approach each new client's situation with an open mind and an open heart. This goes a long way in making those who invite us into their lives feel more cared for, safe and less alone.

What do hospice volunteers do ... if you are a good listener, you are 90% there to being a compassionate companion for your hospice client.

Volunteers keep a hospice client company, doing what the client would like to do. This could be watching TV or playing cards or just talking.

Hospice clients who are getting around (ambulatory) may want you to help them wrap Christmas packages, take a ride to see the water, get their hair done, go out for an ice cream, look through photo albums or sit and visit quietly. Your client will have a life story to share with you.

Some volunteers sit with a client who sleeps throughout the whole visit. However, because the volunteer is present, the care giver can rest, work in the garden, run an errand, go to an appointment, attend a grand child's basket ball game, go to church and more.

Some volunteers walk a hospice client's dog, or run and errand.

If you like to cook, you may ask your client what they like and bring over a surprise meal for the family. This is not expected, but some volunteers love to cook.

Hospice volunteers do not do hands on care such as bathing a client. Hospice volunteers do not handle any medications. Hospice volunteers do not take the place of the dedicated hospice nurses from Community Health & Counseling Services, whom we work closely with as part of a team.
