1-4-24 – Nearly half of American's are upset the US Postal Service is raising the price of regular stamps by two cents. But an overwhelming majority have no clue what the current price is ... for now it's 66 cents they'll raise it to 68 cents January 21st.

1-5-24 – Experts are warning against a risky new trend where people are permanently changing the color of their eyes. Doctors say all the procedures can cause serious complications including total blindness.

1-8-24 – NASA is heading back to the Moon. The first US lunar lander in over 50 years is now on its way to the Moon after a successful launch this morning.

Don't be alarmed if you see hissing mushroom growing in Texas this winter. The unique mushrooms are known as Texas Stars because of their star-like shape and are only grown here and in Japan. The fungus makes an audible hiss when they release their spores.

March:

3-7-24 – Powerball is worth over half a billion dollars after no big winner last night. The jackpot grows to \$521 Million for Saturday's drawing.
