#### Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

A. Lose Weight or Die – While Texas has historically been at the top of the list as far as obesity rate in the U.S., the Lone Star State currently has the 12<sup>th</sup> highest rate with 35.7%. So, while things have gotten better, obesity is still a major issue. This segment was an inspiration to those looking to better their health.

B. **Pedestrian Deaths** – According to the Governors Highway Safety Association, pedestrian deaths have hit 40 year high. TXDOT reports that pedestrian traffic fatalities have increased an astonishing 29.6%.

C. **Growing Risk of Wildfires** – In 2022, over 671,000 acres were burned in Texas making the Lone Star State the third highest state burned by wildfires according to Texas A&M Forest Services. With the dry heat in the summer and usual lack of rain, it is ever so important to stay up to date with potential fire risks, especially in the summer time.

D. **Never Good Enough** – Texas has once again ranked last in mental health resources. In 2022, 314,000 young Texans have depression of some type and 64.7% said they did not receive help in the last year.

E. **Interesting Origins of Cannabis** – History suggests cannabis has been around for well over 10,000 years. And, with Texas legalizing medical marijuana and the rise of CBD, understanding the history of the plant goes far in understanding not only the psychoactive drug, but benefits of the plant that is used for clothing, animal feed, rope and other uses.
