KEOM-FM and HD1 is a non-commercial station, owned and operated by Mesquite Independent School District. Licensed in Mesquite, TX, this 61,000 watt station serves the Dallas area. KEOM airs a variety of community focused programming including public service announcements, locally produced programming, and syndicated programming that address issues of concern to our audience.

As a service to the local listening area, traffic reports are given up to three times an hour when staff and students are on-air. Local weather reports are given twice during most hours, both live and recorded. In addition, KEOM airs Emergency Alert Notifications regarding local and national emergencies, including Amber Alerts and during periods of severe weather.

KEOM has determined the following issues of concern to our audience:
