- A. Senior citizen care, resources and support help

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 8, 2023 at 6:36:50 a.m. Duration 10 minutes and 40 seconds. A segment with Megan Word, Chief of Community Engagement of Foundation for Senior Living. Foundation for Senior Living has been serving the Arizona community since 1974 in which it offers affordable housing to senior citizens. There is a qualification process required and a wait list for the 25 communities currently active in the Valley. FSL is looking to build more communities for people who need affordable housing. In addition to affordable housing, senior citizens need proper nutrition. And FSL has three food pantries across the Valley that will deliver meals.

A segment with Charles Fuschillo, President and CEO of Alzheimer’s Foundation of America. The mission is to provide support, services and education to individuals, families and caregivers affected by Alzheimer’s disease and related dementias nationwide, and fund research for better treatment and a cure. Alzheimer’s Foundation of America believes in education and the National Educating America Tour begins in Phoenix with a free event full of healthy aging tips, early detection, caregiver tips and strategies, plus local resources to help people and families.

Arizona REALTORS is the largest trade association in Arizona with over 55,000 members. The organization wants to make a difference through the REALTORS are Good Neighbors Initiative and kick started 2023 with a \$15,000 donation to the Arizona Housing Fund. There are inequities in housing and issues that have presented themselves here in Arizona. The Arizona REALTORS organization is committed to building communities and it starts at every level. The Arizona Housing Fund help people who need

access to affordable supportive housing, like disabled and elderly people who have found themselves on hard times.

Greg and his wife, Marianne, started EricsHouse in 2017 after the loss of Marianne’s son to suicide after a long battle with addiction. EricsHouse takes the way people grieve, the differences between males and females in the process and has group or individual sessions. The groups are ran by peer support. There is clinical oversight if needed, but the main functionality is through peer support. EricsHouse wants to make sure people know they aren’t alone and there is help to overcome the hole in someone’s heart.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 8, 2023 at 6:47:45 a.m. Duration 13 minutes and 20 seconds. A segment with Tom Waldreck, President and CEO of Keep Phoenix Beautiful. Keep Phoenix Beautiful is celebrating over 40 years of providing tools to empower the Phoenix community to improve overall quality of life and to achieve a vision that aims to inspire individuals and organizations through leadership, active partnerships and meaningful volunteer experiences. Community gardens are offered through Keep Phoenix Beautiful and with that, they hope to inspire people to take action on their own. Some of the many volunteer opportunities include removing litter from our communities, neighborhoods and parks. Furthermore, recycling is a major part of what Keep Phoenix Beautiful wants to instill in people and their habits. There are upcoming recycling drives for major appliances, computers and more, that often get forgotten.

With the lack of funding during 2020, there has been a major void to the arts community and the Phoenix Art Museum felt the devastating impact. The Men’s Arts Council recently gave a \$1 million grant to fund projects, exhibitions and restore the Maricopa Community College student free admission program.

A segment with Dr. Lawrence Bell, Executive Director of the Arizona Jewish Historical Society. The Arizona Jewish Historical Society offers many exhibits to consumers and is currently working on expanding the Cutler Plotkin Jewish Heritage Center to provide additional educational opportunities to preserve the history of what happened during the Holocaust. It is important to tell the survivor’s stories, share the risks of repeating history and all the different genocides this country has been part.

state of Arizona that provides compassionate care for animals and the people who love them. A fun event with funds going toward supplies and medical care for the animals in need at the AAWL is upcoming with local architects, interior designers and home builders. Sixteen designers will build doghouses with unique and fun decisions. Those doghouses are auctioned with the support for the AAWL and all that they provide to animals to find their forever homes.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on February 5, 2023 at 6:00:00 a.m. Duration 11 minutes. A segment with Pat Schweiss, Executive Director of the Sedona International Film Festival. The 29th Annual Sedona International Film Festival is set for February 18 – 26 in which Lifetime Achievement Awards will be handed out, over 140 films on display with an attention to the arts and film making. The cinematography is a great way to share artistic expression and this festival brings it all together.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 5, 2023 at 6:33:00 a.m. Duration 13 minutes and 25 seconds. A segment with Frank Guzzo, Italian Association Executive Director. The 8th Annual Italian Festival will be coming back to downtown Phoenix. And for the first time ever, the Sun City Italian Festival will be heading to the west valley. As a nonprofit, the Italian Association's goal is to educate people on the Italian culture, heritage, foods, music and fun. The joy of giving back to the community and highlighting the Italian culture all make up for a fun weekend of festivities.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 19, 2023 at 6:30:45 a.m. Duration 12 minutes and 5 seconds. A segment with Laura Pahules, Founder and President of Control Alt Delete and Amy Hysell, President and CEO of Arizona Financial Credit Union. Control Alt Delete is a 501©3 nonprofit in Phoenix, Arizona with the primary focus removing the barriers that prevent domestic violence victims from fleeing abusive relationships. Control Alt Delete Connects domestic violence victims with community resources and support by providing basic immediate needs. The average cost for a person to leave an abusive situation is \$21.75. That money is provided by generous grants, like the one given by Arizona Financial Credit Union through their Local Causes Grant Program. Arizona has the fifth-highest domestic violence rates in the US with 42.6 percent of women experiencing intimate partner physical violence, sexual violence or stalking.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 26, 2023 at 6:39:05 a.m. Duration 11 minutes. A segment with Mike Lair, Director of Integrated Fundraising and Annual Giving with Phoenix Children's Hospital. The state of Arizona offers a dollar for dollar tax credit for singles up to \$400 and couples up to \$800. There is still time to make a donation before taxes are due and have them be claimed on your 2022 taxes. Phoenix Children's Hospital accepts those dollar for dollar tax donations and they help tremendously with the efforts to continue to be a world-renowned hospital providing the best care to children.

C. Homelessness, housing and hunger

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 1, 2023 at 6:39:05 a.m. and January 29, 2023 at 6:06:55 a.m. Duration 13 minutes and 10 seconds. A segment with Amy Schwabenlender, Human Services Campus Executive Director. The Human Services Campus was founded back in 2005 with a

collaborative force of partner organizations united on one campus to end homelessness. Right now, the Human Services Campus is seeing about 900 people per day in need of shelter. There aren't enough beds on the campus site, but the Human Services Campus always tries to provide accommodations and care. With the winter months here, blankets and warm clothes are in high demand.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 22, 2023 at 6:00:00 a.m. Duration 12 minutes and 25 seconds. A segment with Donna Bartos, CEO of Bloom365. Bloom365 is a grassroots movement that focuses on sustainable and scalable youth-driven education, advocacy, intervention and activism in schools and organizations across Arizona. The Department of Justice has identified Phoenix as one of the highest human trafficking jurisdictions in the country with 337 cases reported in 2021. The three main types of human trafficking are sex trafficking, forced labor and debt bondage. These three are the most common and getting inside the mindset of a human trafficker, they try to attract people who need something. People who are in search of food and housing are more susceptible to tricks and human trafficking due to all of the presenting circumstances.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 29, 2023 at 6:39:55 a.m. Duration 11 minutes and 15 seconds. A segment with Lisa Travatello, CMO with GENYouth. GENYouth and its partners have a shared purpose, creating healthy school communities by empowering students and providing the resources for youth to build healthy, high-achieving futures. The reality of how many students come to school hungry is unsettling. The amount of students who get their only nutritious meal per day from school is startling. GENYouth has a goal to deliver over 8.5 million school meals to over 31,000 students in Arizona each year. The hope is address some of the hunger and pitfalls of people starving.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 12, 2023 at 6:28:00 a.m. Duration 14 minutes. A segment with Jackson Fonder, CEO of UMOM New Day Centers and Joel Helle, VP of Physician Services with CVS Health. UMOM New Day Centers is a nonprofit serving Maricopa County with a mission to end family homelessness by restoring hope and rebuilding lives. The programs within UMOM New Day Centers are guided by a simple formula, jobs and housing = ending homelessness. UMOM New Day Centers opened a new 60-unit community with the financial support of CVS Health called Newsome Village. Here families can live in a nice, affordable housing community. The start to changing lives, helping people to better health is through proper housing. All residents of UMOM New Day Centers are working and do not get to live there for free.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 12, 2023 at 6:00:00 a.m. Duration 8 minutes. A segment with Jason Reed, President and CEO of United Food Bank. United Food Bank has provided hunger relief to people in the Easy Valley and eastern Arizona since 1983. United Food Bank is a Feeding America Member, which means its organization is part of a 200-group coalition across the country, all working in unison to help the hunger crisis in America. Currently one in six in Arizona are experience food insecurity and United Food Bank is here to help that. Food insecurity can lead to other health related issues.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 26, 2023 at 6:21:50 a.m. Duration 17 minutes. A segment with Lisa Masters, Founder of Autism Life and Living. Autism Life and Living is set to empower young adults with autism by providing programs that promote inclusion, independence, socialization and well-being. Staggering numbers that 87 percent of adults with autism in the US live with their parents. When parents get too old to take care of their children with autism, often times they go to group homes, in which there are massive amounts of abusive reports and the care for the individual suffers. There is a need to overcome the barriers for safe and affordable housing for adults living with autism. Autism Life and Living will also be offering programs to support independence and get people on a path to a safe independent living situation.

D. Health care related sources

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 1, 2023 at 6:24:10 a.m. Duration 14 minutes and 40 seconds. A segment with Tom Grote, CEO of Banner Aetna. Banner Aetna offers programs through the exchange of the Affordable Care Act. Tom discussed how the ACA works and the process needed to sign up for health insurance by certain deadlines. Banner Aetna is working to lower premiums for people in Arizona when other health insurers are raising premiums. Everything within Banner Aetna is through their assortment of network options. It is a tough choice for people to make with their health insurance to decide how much to pay per month, cost of a deductible, co-pays, etc. and there are ways that Banner Aetna can help sort through those tough decisions to help someone decide the plan that is best for them.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 1, 2023 at 6:52:30 a.m. and January 8, 2023 at 6:00:00 a.m. Duration 9 minutes and 15 seconds. A segment with Nicole Henry, District Leader with CVS Health. The holiday season brings about more flu, colds and the unfortunate reality of COVID. CVS Health is advocating it isn't too late to get your flu shots if you haven't already done so, in addition to washing your hands for general hygiene practices. When it comes to COVID, if you test positive, pharmacists can now prescribe Paxlovid, for those who qualify. Paxlovid is an antiviral drug that helps reduce the viral load of COVID in hopes to get someone on the mend from the virus.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 15, 2023 at 6:00:00 a.m. Duration 15 minutes and 5 seconds. A segment with Mik Milem, Executive Director of Soldier's Best Friend. Soldier's Best Friend provides US military veterans living with combat-related Post Traumatic Stress Disorder or Traumatic Brain Injury with a Service or Therapeutic Companion dog. Soldier's Best Friend is dedicated to pairing a dog with a veteran at no-cost to the veteran to help get the veteran out in public, help with nightmares and a myriad of other issues that many veterans suffer from when returning to civilian life. The process is a six to nine month training period to get the dog and veteran in sync. The cumulative statistics for how veterans feel their health has improved break down with 94 percent reporting improvement of their overall life and a positive impact in their overall symptoms, 80 percent reporting a positive impact on social activities, and 83 percent who had suicidal thoughts prior to training are now reporting a reduction in those thoughts.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on February 19, 2023 at 6:26:10 a.m. Duration 17 minutes and 20 seconds. A segment with Barb Kozuh, Executive Director of Delta Dental of Arizona Foundation.

Delta Dental of Arizona Foundation has made it a mission to improve lives by promoting optimal oral health care. Delta Dental offers many grants to many different organizations to help with oral health needs, education, awareness and supplies. Upcoming, Delta Dental is partnering with the Great Arizona Puppet Theater to bring a puppet show to Title One schools and daycare centers that focuses on oral health education and make the topic more fun. The hope is that there will be lessons learned for the importance of oral health for your overall health and best practices will be applied at home.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on February 26, 2023 at 6:15:30 a.m. Duration 20 minutes and 30 seconds. A segment with Cara McNulty, DPA, President of Mental Well-Being and Behavioral Health at CVS Health. National Eating Disorders Awareness week is February 27 to March 5. And the awareness needs to be raised about eating disorders and the growing number of people suffering from this disorder. Data shows nearly 1 in 10 Americans will have an eating disorder at some point in their life. Many reasons for why eating disorders are on the rise. Social anxiety, social media pressures, isolation, mental health; it all plays a factor in how eating disorders can manifest themselves. CVS Health is committed to providing resources for people to get help and to be a neighborhood advocate.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 12, 2023 at 6:08:15 a.m. Duration 9 minutes. A segment with Carrie Collins, CEO of Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona. Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona has the vision of a world where all individuals impacted by brain injury thrive in their community. Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona works in a hospital setting with a referral or works in a self-diagnosed setting and helps someone understand the trauma and triggers that have occurred. Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona is there with therapy and treatments needed. And does many things to help family and caregivers with supportive programs and resources.

E. Youth Advocacy

There is a major question in the autism community. What happens when I die? That's a question that parents ask themselves when it comes to their children living with developmental and intellectual disabilities. Across the US, 87 percent of adults with autism live with their parents and there aren't enough conversations about this health related issue. Are there enough programs to help youth become independent and to develop the skills warranted? Is there enough attention placed on affordable housing? Autism Life and Living is trying to teach skills, educate on the need for affordable communities, people to be on the look-out and to develop and autism community for life, skills and independence. It all starts at a youthful age. And it needs the resources to make that community.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 15, 2023 at 6:32:35 a.m. and January 29, 2023 at 6:51:25 a.m. Duration 11 minutes and 40 seconds. A segment with Peter Volny, Organizer and Founder of Concours in the Hills. Councours in the Hills is hosting its ninth annual event benefitting the

Phoenix Children's Hospital. One of the largest car shows in America is right here in the community with the support collaborating with the Phoenix Children's Hospital. Phoenix Children's Hospital gives hope to so many children and families who have heard awful news of a diagnosis. The medications, the treatment, the world-renowned doctors all supporting the children on their quest to better health. Everyone is working in unison for each child and their direct care.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on January 22, 2023 at 6:14:25 a.m. Duration 11 minutes and 20 seconds. A segment with Gus LaZear, Vice President and General Manager of Ability 360 Sports and Fitness Center. The center provides exceptional adaptive sports, recreation, aquatic and fitness programs that promote the independence, health and overall well-being of people with disabilities and their family members. Ability 360 Sports and Fitness Center is the epicenter of various tournaments for youth with disabilities whether it be Wheelchair Soccer, Goalball for the visually impaired, Wheelchair Basketball, and Wheelchair Rugby. These athletes attend from all over the country and some in preparation for the Paralympics. Ability 360 Sports and Fitness Center tries to make it a community, a place of representation and support.

A segment with Matt Manoogian, Board Secretary of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central AZ. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central AZ's mission is to create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. For more than 60 years, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central AZ has operated under the belief that inherent in every child is the ability to succeed and thrive in life. With this belief, "bigs" sign up to help for at least one-year and are paired with a "little" who is between the ages of six and 18. The fostering of these relationships builds self-confidence and children can realize their potential.

Valley Focus – Broadcast on March 12, 2023 at 6:17:30 a.m. and March 19, 2023 at 6:20:15 a.m. Duration 10 minutes and 15 seconds. A segment with Sandi Garcia, Senior Events Planner for Team Taylor. Team Taylor was started in memory of Taylor, a baby who died from SIDS, Sudden Infant Death Syndrome. It isn't often discussed but 2,300 babies die of SIDS in the United States every year and it leaves families and parents shell-shocked and heartbroken. Team Taylor's run helps support the Phoenix Children's Home Safety and Safe Sleep Program this year with active community outreach for preventative measures against SIDS. The Team Taylor Run does an incredible job of honoring the baby's lives and their spirit.

F. Educational and career resources

A segment with Dan Puente, Build Your Future Arizona Steering Committee Chair and Founder and CEO of DP Electric. Build Your Future Arizona's mission is to create a sustainable and skilled craft workforce by creating awareness about high paying construction careers, training opportunities and mapping career paths to employment in these high demand occupations. In Arizona, statistics show a need for 265,145 craft professionals by December of 2024. Often times

Build Your Future Arizona can assist with the different industries of interest and help get a foot in the door.

A segment with Kevin Conquest, Entertainment Director with the Phoenix Scottish Highland Games. The 58th Annual Phoenix Scottish Highland Games are returning to the Valley with a refreshed look after a hiatus due to COVID. The pause allowed for a look into how to proceed forward with the weekend of activities that will include traditional games, Scottish music and dancers, but provide an element of education. One big goal of the event events is to allow people the chance to learn about Scottish heritage, even take a look into their lineage that they may not have had the chance to understand before. It is about fun and education for the weekend of events.

Registered teams, consisting of an owner and pet, offer unconditional love while teaching confidence, respect and empathy. Gabriel's Angels Animal Assisted Reading improves a child's confidence, trust, empathy and emotional development. The interaction with the dogs during the 20-minute session directly works on improving the reading and comprehension skills of the child. Over the course of 12 to 16 weeks, evidence of drastic improvement occurs often times with an increase in a grade level of reading. Reading is the fundamental core to fostering further education and a quality life.

The program powered by Canvas Learning Management System aims to offer quality online education from excellent accredited institutions in 40 languages to learners across the globe. Anyone is eligible for the classes. Learners can go at their own pace at any time of day or night from anywhere in the world for the education. There is core belief to provide education across the world that will foster empowerment, a global economy and sustainability.

Among the programs Keep Phoenix Beautiful offers is through community gardens that inspires people to take action on their own. The many volunteer opportunities include removing litter from our communities, neighborhoods and parks. Recycling is a major part of Keep Phoenix Beautiful with the encouragement to recycle and major recycling events for bigger items such as electronics.

Super Bowl 57 is coming to town in February. The city of Phoenix has a goal for Super Bowl 57 to be Zero Waste. According to the EPA, Zero Waste is defined by diverting 90 percent of waste away from the landfill. Phoenix has taken on a loftier goal, to divert 92 percent of waste, making it the greenest Super Bowl yet. It is important for our environment to divert away from the landfill, whether the product can be recycled or composted. With the expectation of at least 1 million people descending to downtown Phoenix for the week of the Super Bowl, it is important for the city to manage the trash, get it separated into appropriate destinations and achieve the goal of Zero Waste.

With the need to educate and provide children and youth in Arizona with a safe environment, free from abuse and neglect, Child Crisis Arizona went looking to innovate. Ground has broken on a 38,000 square foot facility that will focus on foster care and adoption services, family education, children’s counseling, health and wellness, centralized kitchen and food distribution, centralized administration and philanthropy, foster teen programs, art, dance and music therapy. The thing about the 38,000 square foot facility is that it will be a net zero campus. It was important to have sustainability, save money but as Torrie said, be a leader in green energy and thinking as a way to show kids the future.

Natural Restorations has a mission to remove trash and graffiti from outdoor recreation and wilderness areas, revitalize natural areas through replanting projects and enrich the lives of Military Veterans and other community members. Natural Restorations has a lot of volunteer opportunities to work on projects throughout the community with trash removal. In addition, Natural Restorations has a replanting program in which the organization takes saguaros that will be bulldozed down for new construction and replants them where the 2020 Bush Fire destroyed 80,000 saguaros.
