


1st Quarter 2013

More Winter Weather Brings Snow	NEWS/WEB	2/11/2013	1 Min	<p>A major storm dropped up to 10 inches of snow on most of western and north-central Nebraska, and winds created drifts 2-foot- to 5-foot-deep Sunday.</p> <p>The storm prompted some short highway closures in the Panhandle.</p> <p>National Weather Service forecaster Bill Taylor says the snowfall began tapering off Sunday afternoon. So blizzard warnings will remain in effect for much of Western Nebraska until midnight. Snowfall totals ranged between 4 inches and 10 inches across western Nebraska. The highest total was reported about 40 miles northwest of North Platte.</p> <p>Wind gusts up to 57 mph were reported in Theford. The power was out in Atkinson and Bassett Sunday, but the Nebraska Public Power District was able to restore electricity by late morning.</p>
North Platte & Ogallala Receive GRANTS	NEWS/WEB	2/8/2013	1 Min	<p>Several area organizations, including one in North Platte and two in Ogallala have received grant money to help cleanup, recycle and help fund public education programs and activities. The dollars are a part of more than \$1.7 million issued throughout 55 total grants across the state from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality, NDEQ Director Mike Linder announced the grants in a press release Thursday.</p>
Ogallala Hospital To Remodel	NEWS/WEB	2/15/2013	1 Min	<p>Ogallala Community Hospital has announced a large expansion to increase services in the community. According to the Ogallala Chamber of Commerce, the \$2 million expansion will accommodate more outpatient clinic services as the hospital. Construction is scheduled to begin in the 2nd quarter of 2013 and will involve a 3,800-5,000 square-foot extension of the hospital. It will provide space for additional visiting specialists with five bays for infusion services and cancer care.</p>
