Hour of Harvest, Inc. (“Licensee”), the licensee of Station WLJC-TV, Beattyville, KY, hereby responds to the March 26, 2024 Letter (the “Audit Letter”) from Elizabeth E. Goldin, Assistant Chief, Investigations & Hearings Division, Federal Communications Commission.

The Audit Letter states that the station employment unit (“SEU”) for Station WLJC-TV has been selected for an audit of its EEO program. There are three co-owned stations in the SEU: WLJC-TV, Beattyville, KY, WLJC-FM, Beattyville, KY, and WEBF-FM, Lerosé, KY.

**Question 2(a)**

The SEU has fewer than five full-time employees. The job titles and number of hours each is regularly assigned is as follows:

1. Production Manager: 37.5 hours;
2. Grounds and Maintenance Supervisor: 38 hours;
3. Station program Manager: 35 hours; and
4. Safety and Security Manager: 36.5 hours.

**Question 2(b)(vi)**

The SEU had no pending or resolved complaints alleging unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex during the license period.

**Question 3**

Stations WLJC-FM and WEBF-FM are party to a time brokerage agreement with Educational Media Foundation. Hour of Harvest provided notice to EMF, and EMF submitted its response, dated April 11, 2024.
