CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL TO NAME NOMINEES FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMISSION

THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE IS TAKING ANOTHER STEP TODAY TO SOLVE THE CITY'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING CRISIS. TODAY, COUNCIL IS EXPECTED TO NAME ITS NOMINEES FOR THE "NEST" COMMISSION. "NEST" STANDS FOR "NEIGHBORHOOD EQUITY AND STABILIZATION." COUNCIL ESTABLISHED THE NEST COMMISSION IN AUGUST. IT WILL BE MADE UP OF A GROUP OF RESIDENTS FOCUSED ON PROTECTING VULNERABLE NEIGHBORS FROM GENTRIFICATION. FOR YEARS, CHANNEL NINE HAS TOLD YOU ABOUT HISTORIC NEIGHBORHOODS LIKE CHERRY, DRUID HILLS AND DOUBLE OAKS THAT ARE SEEING AN INCREASE IN NEW DEVELOPMENT AND PUSHING OUT ONCE AFFORDABLE HOMES. TO FIGHT THAT PROBLEM, THE NEST COMMISSION WILL APPOINT NEIGHBORHOOD LEADERS, HOUSING ADVOCATES AND PEOPLE WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED DISPLACEMENT FIRSTHAND. THEIR GOAL WILL BE TO REVIEW AND RECOMMEND ANTI-DISPLACEMENT STRATEGIES AND TOOLS TO IDENTIFY AND HELP THOSE WHO ARE MOST AT RISK. THE COMMISSION WILL ALSO INCLUDE DEVELOPERS AND FINANCE ADVISERS TO HELP WITH LAND USE AND URBAN PLANNING.

OCTOBER 5, 2021 NOON

MECKLENBURG CO. COMMISSIONERS CONSIDER EXPANDING NONDISCRIMINATION RULES

TONIGHT, MECKLENBURG COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WILL DECIDE BETWEEN TWO PROPOSALS TO EXPAND THE COUNTY'S NON-DISCRIMINATION ORDINANCE. ONE OF THOSE PROPOSALS WOULD ADD JOB PROTECTIONS AT SMALL BUSINESSES FOR LGBTQ EMPLOYEES AND WORKERS WITH NATURAL HAIR. THE OTHER WOULD APPLY EXPANDED NONDISCRIMINATION LAWS TO BUSINESSES OF ALL SIZES. RIGHT NOW, STATE AND FEDERAL LAW ONLY PROHIBITS THESE FORMS OF EMPLOYEE DISCRIMINATION AT BUSINESSES WITH 15 OR MORE WORKERS. EMPLOYMENT PROVISIONS FOR THE COUNTY COULD GO INTO EFFECT AS SOON AS JANUARY FIRST. A SEPARATE ORDINANCE FROM THE COUNTY WOULD ALSO PROHIBIT DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC PLACES LIKE PARKS. THE COUNTY FOLLOWS THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE. YOU MAY REMEMBER CITY COUNCIL EXPANDED ITS NON-DISCRIMINATION ORDINANCE BACK IN AUGUST.

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL TO CONSIDER TERROR PREPAREDNESS GRANT

TOMORROW NIGHT, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL VOTE ON MILLIONS OF DOLLARS TO KEEP YOU SAFE. THEY'RE EXPECTED TO SIGN OFF ON ACCEPTING A \$3 MILLION GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY. THAT MONEY WILL BE USED FOR THINGS LIKE POLICE EQUIPMENT, COUNTERING DOMESTIC EXTREMISM AND TECHNOLOGY FOR ADDRESSING CYBERSECURITY THREATS.

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL TO GET IDEAS ON CITY'S FUTURE FROM WINSTON-SALEM

A STEP FORWARD TODAY IN A MAJOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECT. MEMBERS OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY COMMISSION WILL TRAVEL TO WINSTON-SALEM. THEY'LL BE THERE TO TOUR THE INNOVATION QUARTER TO GET IDEAS ON HOW TO PLAN FOR CHARLOTTE'S FIRST MEDICAL SCHOOL. THE INNOVATION QUARTER IS A SPRAWLING CAMPUS SURROUNDING WAKE FOREST MEDICAL SCHOOL. HOW IT'S LAID OUT WILL HELP LOCAL LEADERS UNDERSTAND WHAT'S POSSIBLE HERE. WE TOLD YOU BACK IN MARCH ATRIUM AND WAKE FOREST PLAN TO BUILD CHARLOTTE'S MEDICAL SCHOOL AT BAXTER & SOUTH MCDOWELL STREETS, NEXT TO THE JOHN BELK FREEWAY. CONSTRUCTION BEGINS EARLY NEXT YEAR.

NOVEMBER 1, 2021 6:00AM

CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG GOVERNMENT CENTER TO REOPEN

TODAY, THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG GOVERNMENT CENTER IS EXPECTED TO REOPEN TO THE PUBLIC. THE BUILDING HAD BEEN CLOSED DURING MUCH OF THE PANDEMIC, BUT OFFICIALS REOPENED IT TWO WEEKS AGO FOR PEOPLE TO ATTEND SOME MEETINGS, INCLUDING CITY COUNCIL AND THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG SCHOOL BOARD. BUT STARTING TODAY, PEOPLE CAN ALSO GO TO THE GOVERNMENT CENTER DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS.

NOVEMBER 4, 2021 6:00AM

CONCERNS OVER CHARLOTTE'S NEW ELECTION DISTRICTS

A GROUP OF CHARLOTTE NEIGHBORS IS ON A MISSION TO PROTECT THEIR COMMUNITY AS THE CITY MOVES INTO THE FUTURE. CHARLOTTE CITY LEADERS HAVE TO REDRAW ELECTION DISTRICT LINES, WHICH COULD CHANGE WHO REPRESENTS PEOPLE IN HIDDEN VALLEY. THE CURRENT PROPOSAL WOULD MOVE HIDDEN VALLEY FROM DISTRICT FOUR TO DISTRICT ONE, LUMPED WITH NEIGHBORHOODS LIKE PLAZA MIDWOOD, DILWORTH AND MYERS PARK. PEOPLE IN HIDDEN VALLEY WORRY THEY WOULD BE OVERLOOKED IN A NEW DISTRICT. THEY'RE TAKING THE CASE TO FEDERAL COURT, ASKING FOR A JUDGE TO DELAY COUNCIL'S DECISION. WE REACHED OUT TO THE CITY, BUT A SPOKESPERSON COULDN'T COMMENT BECAUSE THE CASE IS IN COURT. COUNCIL HAS UNTIL NOVEMBER 17TH TO APPROVE A MAP.

CHARLOTTE LEADERS TO VOTE ON NEW POLICE VESTS

CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG POLICE OFFICERS COULD BE GETTING NEW BULLETPROOF VESTS SOON. CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL IS SET TO VOTE ON THE PURCHASE TOMORROW NIGHT. CMPD USUALLY NEEDS ABOUT 300 TO 400 NEW VESTS EVERY YEAR, TALLYING UP TO AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$526,000.

NOVEMBER 8, 2021 5:00AM

CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE \$8M CHARLOTTE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

TODAY CITY COUNCIL WILL SIGN OFF ON A \$8 MILLION PROJECT IN CHARLOTTE. IT WOULD IMPROVE LAKEVIEW ROAD NEAR OLD STATESVILLE ROAD. THE UPGRADE WILL ADD NEW LANES, MAKE THE STREET SAFER FOR BICYCLISTS AND IMPROVE THE INTERSECTION. CONSTRUCTION SHOULD BE FINISHED BY THE END OF 2024.

DECEMBER 3, 2021 6:00AM

YORK COUNTY COUNCIL SUPPORTS PLAN TO TURN "GOAT FARM" INTO REC SPACE

IN YORK COUNTY, NEIGHBORS OVERWHELMED BY GROWTH ARE TAKING STEPS TO MAKE SURE THEY HAVE GREEN SPACE IN THEIR COMMUNITY. THEY JUST BOUGHT 87 ACRES IN CLOVER ONCE KNOWN AS "THE GOAT FARM." THEY DON'T PLAN TO STOP THERE. NEIGHBORS ACTUALLY VOTED TO INCREASE THEIR OWN TAXES TO BE ABLE TO PAY FOR THE PROPERTY. IT WILL NOW BE PRESERVED AS GREENSPACE AND USED FOR RECREATION ONLY, THINGS LIKE HIKING AND FESTIVALS. IT'S A PLAN THE COUNTY CONCIL AGREES WITH. THE PROPERTY COULD OPEN AS EARLY AS JANUARY.

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL TO DISCUSS NEXT 20 YEARS OF CITY'S FUTURE

THIS AFTERNOON, CITY COUNCIL WILL HOLD A SPECIAL MEETING TO DISCUSS ALMOST 20 YEARS OF CHARLOTTE'S FUTURE. THEY'RE PLANNING TO WORK WITH MAYOR VI LYLES AT 3 PM ON THE MAP FOR "CHARLOTTE FUTURE 2040." IT INCLUDES PLANS FOR POSSIBLE NEW HOMES, BUSINESSES AND PARKS.

DECEMBER 7, 2021 5:00AM

MECKLENBURG COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO VOTE ON INNOVATION DISTRICT

TODAY, MECKLENBURG COUNTY LEADERS ARE EXPECTED TO VOTE ON PLANS FOR THE INNOVATION DISTRICT. A NEW MEDICAL SCHOOL WILL ANCHOR THE PROJECT. LAST MONTH, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL VOTED TO GIVE ATRIUM HEALTH THE TAX SUPPORT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT. TODAY, COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WILL CONSIDER THEIR ROLE IN THE GRANT. THE INNOVATION DISTRICT IS PROJECTED TO BRING MORE THAN 5,000 JOBS TO OUR REGION.

TROUTMAN LEADERS APPROVE DEVELOPMENT DESPITE COMMUNITY OPPOSITION

TROUTMAN IS ONE STEP CLOSER TO GETTING A NEW FULFILLMENT CENTER. COUNCIL LEADERS UNANIMOUSLY VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE DEVELOPMENT LAST NIGHT. TOWN LEADERS SAY TWO COMPANIES ARE INTERESTED IN THE 160-ACRE PLOT OF LAND. THEY SAY THE DEVELOPMENT WOULD BRING HUNDREDS OF NEW JOBS. BUT SOME RESIDENTS ARE CONCERNED THAT IT GOES AGAINST THE TOWN CULTURE.

POLICE INVESTIGATE MURDER IN NORTHEAST CHARLOTTE

CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG POLICE IDENTIFIED THE VICTIM OF AN OVERNIGHT HOMICIDE IN NORTHEAST CHARLOTTE AS ERIC DEESE II. POLICE SAY IT HAPPENED ON FARMINGTON RIDGE PARKWAY OFF CALDWELL ROAD AROUND 10 P.M. LIMITED DETAILS HAVE BEEN RELEASED ABOUT WHAT HAPPENED, BUT WE ARE FOLLOWING UP WITH POLICE AND WILL LET YOU KNOW ONCE WE LEARN MORE.

OCTOBER 9, 2021 11:00PM

LANCASTER COUNTY SHERIFF ARRESTS SUSPECT IN DEADLY SHOOTING

A WOMAN DIED TODAY AFTER INVESTIGATORS SAY SHE WAS SHOT SEVERAL TIMES DURING AN ARGUMENT. THE LANCASTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE SAYS IT HAPPENED AT A HOME ON CAROLINA COURT. INVESTIGATORS SAY CURTIS TOWNSEND SHOT TAKEISHA MASSEY, THEN THREW THE GUN IN A TRASH CAN. MASSEY DIED SHORTLY AFTER SHE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL. POLICE ARRESTED TOWNSEND THIS AFTERNOON.

OCTOBER 12, 2021 5:00AM

JEWELRY STORE ROBBERY CAUGHT ON CAMERA

THIS MORNING, POLICE IN ROCK HILL ARE SEARCHING FOR TWO MEN CAUGHT ON CAMERA ROBBING A JEWELRY STORE. IT ALL HAPPENED IN THE ROCK HILL GALLERIA FRIDAY NIGHT AT ADAM'S JEWELERS. POLICE SAY THE TWO MEN USED A SERVICE HALLWAY MEANT FOR EMPLOYEES AND WENT STRAIGHT FOR THE JEWELRY STORE. THE CLERK RAN AWAY, YELLING FOR HELP, WHILE ONE OF THE MEN JUMPED OVER THE COUNTER. SHE SAID SHE HEARD TWO SHOTS, BUT DIDN'T LOOK BACK. THE MEN DIDN'T MESS WITH THE JEWELS ON DISPLAY. THEY WENT TO THE SAFE, GRABBED WHAT THEY COULD AND RAN. THERE WAS A CARNIVAL HAPPENING OUTSIDE THE MALL AT THE TIME OF THE ROBBERY. POLICE ARE ASKING ANYONE WHO WAS THERE TO SPEAK UP IF THEY SAW ANYTHING.

MOTHER ACCUSED OF SETTING FIRE THAT KILLED HER BABY

THIS MORNING, A ROCK HILL MOTHER FACES CHARGES THAT SHE SET A HOUSE FIRE THAT KILLED HER OWN BABY. OFFICERS ARRESTED LAQUITA HENDERSON YESTERDAY. THEY SAY HER HOUSE WAS ON FIRE AND SHE TOLD THEM HER BABY WAS INSIDE. THE BABY DIED. POLICE CHARGED HENDERSON WITH ARSON. INVESTIGATORS SAY THEY ARE CONSIDERING OTHER CHARGES AS WELL.

MOORESVILLE POLICE INVESTIGATE SHOOTING

BREAKING NEWS IN MOORESVILLE... POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING A SHOOTING. IT HAPPENED ON MECKLYNN ROAD. OUR CREW ON SCENE SAYS THE SCENE WAS WIDESPREAD WITH COPS OUT FROM I-77 ALL THE WAY UP TO THIS GAS STATION. POLICE HAD CRIME SCENE TAPE WRAPPED AROUND A BLACK CAR. WE STILL DON'T KNOW WHAT LED UP TO THE SHOOTING. THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE TOLD US MORE INFORMATION WOULD BE COMING.

TEEN GIRL SHOT, KILLED IN FRONT OF HER HOME

A TEENAGE GIRL IS DEAD, SHOT AND KILLED IN FRONT OF HER OWN HOME IN CLEVELAND COUNTY. THIS MORNING, POLICE ARE SEARCHING FOR HER KILLER. OFFICERS TELL CHANNEL 9 IT HAPPENED ALONG ROBERTS AND MARTIN STREETS IN SHELBY JUST BEFORE 4 YESTERDAY AFTERNOON. POLICE ARE STILL IN THE PROCESS OF NOTIFYING FAMILY, SO THEY'RE HOLIDING OFF ON RELEASING THE NAME. IF YOU KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT THIS SHOOTING, PLEASE CONTACT SHELBY POLICE.

WOMAN FOUND DEAD INSIDE SKI RENTAL, POLICE SAY IT WASN'T AN ACCIDENT

POLICE SAY A WOMAN WAS FOUND DEAD INSIDE OF A SKI RENTAL AT BEECH MOUNTAIN. INVESTIGATORS SAY THE VICTIM'S NAME IS BETSY DELLINGER. HER FAMILY TELLS CHANNEL 9 BOTH HER CELL PHONE AND CAR ARE MISSING. POLICE SAY THEY BELEIVE SHE DIED BY "NON-ACCIDENTAL MEANS".

CRIME SPREE ENDS IN DEADLY OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

DEVELOPING OVERNIGHT IN GASTON COUNTY... WE WERE THERE AS POLICE LOOKED FOR CLUES AT A CONVENIENCE STORE WHERE A VIOLENT, TWO-COUNTY CRIME SPREE CAME TO AN END. POLICE SAY IT ALL STARTED WITH AN ARMED ROBBERY. OFFICERS SAY THE SUSPECT HELD UP A WOMAN AT AN HVAC STORE IN CLEVELAND COUNTY, STEALING HER PHONE, MONEY AND WEDDING RING. POLICE RESPONDED AND THE SUSPECT RAN. OFFICERS SAY HE WENT INTO THE CREEKSIDE MARKET DELI IN CHERRYVILLE AND HELD MULTIPLE PEOPLE HOSTAGE THERE. POLICE SAY WHEN THEY APPROACHED THE SUSPECT, AT LEAST ONE OFFICER FIRED SHOTS. THE SUSPECT DIED. NO ONE ELSE WAS HURT. THE STATE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION IS LOOKING INTO THE SHOOTING. WE'LL UPDATE YOU AS WE LEARN MORE.

MAN SHOT AND KILLED IN EAST CHARLOTTE

WE'RE LEARNING MORE ABOUT THE MAN POLICE SAY WAS KILLED OUTSIDE AN EAST CHARLOTTE HOME FOLLOWING AN ARGUMENT. DETREYE WALKER WAS SHOT LAST NIGHT ALONG LAWYERS ROAD NEAR W.T. HARRIS BOULEVARD. WHILE POLICE HAVEN'T SAID WHO KILLED WALKER, WE KNOW THE TWO KNEW EACH OTHER.

DECEMBER 6, 2021 6:00PM

POLICE SEARCH FOR PERSON WHO SHOT AND KILLED 19-YEAR-OLD

CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG POLICE ARE LOOKING FOR THE GUNMAN WHO SHOT AND KILLED A 19-YEAR-OLD IN NORTH CHARLOTTE. POLICE RESPONDED TO ELIZABETH DRIVE JUST BEFORE 3 A.M. YESTERDAY. WITNESSES TOLD POLICE SOMEONE TOOK THE VICTIM, DANIEL MORALES, TO THE HOSPITAL. OFFICERS LATER FOUND MORALES DEAD INSIDE A CAR ON EAST INDEPENDENCE BOULEVARD.

DECEMBER 8, 2021 5:00AM

POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN SHOOTING IN HEART OF CHARLOTTE

WE'RE WORKING TO LEARN MORE ABOUT A BRAZEN SHOOTING IN THE HEART OF UPTOWN CHARLOTTE. IT HAPPENED IN THE MIDDLE OF THE DAY YESTERDAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF TRADE AND TRYON STREETS. FROM CHOPPER NINE WE COULD SEE CRIME SCENE TAPE AND EVIDENCE MARKERS IN THE ROAD. POLICE SAY THE SHOOTER GOT OUT OF A CAR AND IMMEDIATELY FIRED 10 TO 15 SHOTS BACK INTO THE CAR. POLICE WERE JUST A FEW FEET AWAY AND QUICKLY ARRESTED THE SUSPECT. OFFICERS SAY NO INNOCENT BYSTANDERS WERE HURT. THEY DO NOT BELIEVE THE PERSON IN THE CAR WAS SHOT.

DECEMBER 13, 2021 6:00AM

POLICE INVESTIGATE STABBING IN WEST CHARLOTTE

POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING A STABBING ON WEST TYVOLA ROAD NEAR BILLY GRAHAM PARKWAY IN WEST CHARLOTTE. MEDIC SAYS ONE PERSON IS HURT. CMPD SAYS THEY HAVE ONE SUSPECT IN CUSTODY AND THAT THE SUSPECT KNEW THE VICTIM. OCTOBER 7, 2021 6:00AM
