Section I. Issues

“Sunday Focus”

This weekly 30-minute program addresses significant issues facing Sioux Falls and the surrounding area. Below are the issues addressed during this quarter:

The stations listed above have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **Health/Mental Health:** We covered a variety of issues that pertained to the overall health and mental health of South Dakotans.
- B. **State Elections:** We addressed a variety of issues that pertained to the upcoming Fall 2022 election cycle here in South Dakota. Among those discussed was the Gubernatorial election between incumbent Governor Kristi Noem, Democratic challenger Jamie Smith and Independent Tracey Quint.
- C. **State Tourism/Public Safety:** We discussed the impact pheasant hunting season has on the tourism industry in the state as well as the challenges it presents for public safety.
- D. **Education:** We discussed a variety of education-related issues relating to South Dakota Public Schools and how some districts within the state use unconventional ways to help fundraise for their students.
- E. **Business:** We covered a number of business-related issues and discussed the overall business climate in the state.
- F. **Charity/Non-Profits:** We discussed “The Day of Giving” event and how it is benefiting one non-profit organization within the community.
- G. **Public Safety:** We discussed an upcoming fundraiser for the local abuse shelter in the community (Children’s Shelter for Home Safety) and what is being done to assist victims staying in the shelter during the upcoming holiday season.
