Quarterly Issues Programs List Stations: WPST-FM / WNJE-AM / WCHR-FM October 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023

Section I. Issues

The stations have identified the following topics as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- **A.** Public Health/AIDS Epidemic: Nearly 30,000 individuals in the Great Philadelphia area are living with HIV. Philadelphians are being infected with HIV at a rate five times five times the national average, and currently there is no cure for the disease. Access to education, healthcare and resources is vital for keeping the population safe as the science continues to advance.
- **B. LGBTQ Issues.** LGBTQ youth in New Jersey face higher risks for depression, anxiety, and suicide. A recent Trevor Project survey found that 71% of LGBTQ youth in New Jersey repotted experiencing symptoms of anxiety, and at least 40% of LGBTQ youth in New Jersey seriously considered suicide in the past year. Providing support for LGBTQ youth at home and in our communities is vital to keeping them safe.
- C. Public Health/Cancer Awareness: Cancer takes a devastating toll on New Jersey. It's estimated that one in two men and one in three women from New Jersey will get a cancer diagnosis in their lifetimes. A cancer diagnosis results in both physical and financial burdens for these individuals and their loved ones as they battle the disease. Routine screenings and awareness are vital for the public's health.
- **D.** Child Safety/Youth Bullying: It's estimated that about 20% of students in New Jersey and Pennsylvania (ages 12-18) have experienced bullying. As the school year continues, our youth is at risk to face bullying in the classroom once again this quarter.
- **E. Fire Safety.** More than one-quarter (26%) of all fires reported in New Jersey in the past decade took place inside private residences. With larger gatherings, decorations, candles and more, the risk of household fires increases every holiday season in New Jersey.
- F. **Disaster Preparedness:** In a typical year New Jersey and Pennsylvania face the risk of all types wintry weather (including snow, ice, freezing temperatures and more), which residents at risk on the highways and in their homes. Public preparedness and disaster planning for these emergencies is crucial to saving lives when wintry weather affects us.
