This program addresses how women may find help in making peace with themselves and how to find forgiveness.

They also share how one can help and ministry to those who have suffered a loss of a child.

Do we let things hold us back? Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

It's the Spirit of God that leads and guides us if we are willing to listen. Bill explains how the Holy Spirit overshadowed people in the Old Testament but in the New Testament the Holy Spirit indwells believers and is available to all who believe today.

He was a follower of Islam and came to accept Jesus Christ. He began to read from the Bible and follow the messages of Scripture. He became a leader in a Christian church in his home town and soon found himself an object of persecution, resulting in acid being thrown on his face. He sustained serious burns and yet, he teaches a message of love and grace for those who reject the Name of Christ.
