In Part One, Bill Harris focuses his teachings on how to overcome regrets of our past. We often think we can hide from our guilt and shame from our past sins but God wants us to deal with our past so healing can begin."If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

As Christians we need to remember we are in this world but not of this world. As children of God, He has given us resources to overcome the trials of this world. Many people worry about their work, financial situation, health, and what others think; this often leads to other issues. God offers us His peace, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28-30. We need to allow God to lead and guide us.
Victory Over Regrets, Worries and Anxieties Part 3	In The Word	10/15, 10/18, and 10/20	6:30pm, 12:30pm, and 8:30pm respectively	30 minutes	Reverend Bill Harris concludes his three-part series on Victory Over Regrets, Worries, and Anxieties. This teaching focuses on overcoming our anxieties of the future. Biblical example of anxiety can be seen in Moses who did not know his future and feel qualified to God's calling. God is not necessarily looking at your abilities; He's looking at your availability. Bill discusses five attitudes for the future. We should strive to have a Philippians 4:6-7 attitude, which is a calm God-centered and trusting attitude.

Salvation comes through being born again, only through Jesus Christ and having a personal relationship with the Creator of the universe. This relationship stems from a transformation of a person's life from a sinful state of being into a follower of Jesus Christ.

God desires to have fellowship with us. He is a holy God where there can be no sin. Jesus demonstrated total surrender when he died on the cross for our sins. This was the only time Jesus was separated from God and the Holy Spirit. Jesus said not my will but yours. We need to submit to God, be in prayer and allow the Lord to lead us.

Bill Harris takes a look the differences of being led by the Spirit verses being led by our own head knowledge. The Holy Spirit tries to lead us but often times we makes decisions based on what we can see around us. Bill discusses the breakdown of the body (sense knowledge), soul (intellectual knowledge), and spirit (revelation knowledge). After Christ death and resurrection, we as believers have the Holy Spirit dwelling within us helping us to know the right path.

We need to strive to have the mind of the Holy Spirit as in Romans 8:6.

There is so much division in our country, state, in our neighborhood. How has God called us to get along with others? God looks at our actions but also our motives.
