

On May 9, 2019, Robert G. Liggett, Jr. applied to the Federal Communications Commission for consent to transfer control of Liggett Communications, LLC (the LLC) to Victoria L. Liggett. The LLC is the licensee of FM Translator Stations: W224DT, Channel 224D, 92.7 MHz, Port Huron, Michigan; and W288BT, Channel 288D, 105.5 MHz, St. Clair, Michigan. FM Translator Station W224DT rebroadcasts the programming of WHLX(AM), 1590 kHz, Marine City, Michigan. FM Translator Station W288BT rebroadcasts the programming of Station WHLS(AM), 1450 kHz, Port Huron, Michigan.

The LLC is a Michigan Limited Liability Company. The LLC has two members: The Robert G. Liggett, Jr. Revocable Trust, which holds 80% of the equity, and which exercises 80% voting power; and The James A. Jensen Trust, which holds 20% of the equity, and which exercises 20% voting power. Robert G. Liggett, Jr. is the Trustee of The Robert G. Liggett, Jr. Revocable Trust. James A. Jensen is the Trustee of The James A. Jensen Trust. James A. Jensen is the President of the LLC. Victoria L. Liggett is the Vice-President of the LLC, and is the spouse of Robert G. Liggett, Jr.


