Re: Public Awareness/Quarterly Issues

In the period from July 1, 2019, through September 30, 2019, KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of July, our ministry participated in several events, including the "Red, White, and Boom" event in Oklahoma City on July 4th; the Arkansas City Christian Church Community Rally; and the acoustic performance of Christian Artist Landry Cantrell in Oklahoma City. The radio stations also promoted a listener-driven contest called "Homie's Homerun Derby" where the winner received four tickets to the Oklahoma City Dodgers' Faith and Family Night baseball game with staff from The House FM. In August, the ministry promoted and participated in several "Back to School" community events in Norman, Ponca City, Enid, Yukon, and Shawnee. KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF also hosted a free CD-signing event with the christian artists *For King and Country* at a bookstore in Edmond, and participated in a community block party in Newkirk. In September, we held an on-air Teacher Appreciation Contest where listeners nominated their favorite broadcast-area teacher for the chance to win a Keurig Coffee Maker and a \$100 Visa Gift Card for supplies for his/her classroom; promoted three concerts, including Zach Williams at the Kansas State Fair; and sponsored and participated in the inaugural weekly prayer service at the historic Poncan Theater in Ponca City. KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF also recruited paid interns at the Oklahoma Christian University Job Fair in Edmond, and held the radio ministry's first Fall Fundraiser. The House FM network also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets, other issues are listed which were broadcast on the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday from 5-5:30 a.m.
