Re: Public Awareness/Quarterly Issues

In the period from October 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019, radio stations KJTH/KXTH/KZTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of October, we had a promotion for our annual "Minister Appreciation Month" contest. Listeners had the opportunity to nominate their favorite minister to win two great prizes: A \$250 Visa Gift Card and two tickets to the Michael W. Smith Concert in either Wichita, KS, or Oklahoma City, OK. We also our 18th annual "Kid DJ Day", the ministry's largest outreach event. More than 400 kids were interviewed by a DJ on-air. Their parents/grandparents then received an email with the recording for memory purposes. Oklahoma veteran stormchaser Val Castor from News 9 in Oklahoma City also spoke with kids and their families about the powerful storms and tornadoes that move through Oklahoma and Kansas. In November, we partnered with First Baptist Church in Norman, Oklahoma to host a concert with the well-known group "Sidewalk Prophets", and we also partnered with the Salvation Army in five of our broadcast locations to present our annual "Turkey For Tunes" promotion. "Turkey For Tunes" encourages listeners to bring frozen turkeys to area locations to donate to the Salvation Army to be given to families in need during the holiday season. More than 230 turkeys were donated. We also sponsored the Michael W. Smith concert in Wichita, helping to promote the concert in a historic Wichita theater. In December, we participated in Christmas Parades in four communities in our broadcast area, and also partnered with the "Festival of Angels" organization in Ponca City to pass out candy canes and Ponca City Holiday Events information cards to more than 20,000 motorists that came to see the hundreds of statuesque lighting displays at Lake Ponca in Ponca City, Oklahoma. We also raised more than \$24,000 in a one-day on-air fundraiser to help meet the ministry's budget needs. As part of the fundraiser, we partnered with the regional Food Banks in Kansas and Oklahoma to help feed one family for every donation made to the radio ministry during the fundraiser. Thanks to the support of our listeners, 1,260 families were fed through the partnership. Throughout the three month period, we also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets other issues are listed which were broadcast in the program "Focus on the Family". " "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday morning at 5:00 a.m.
