Re: Public Awareness/Quarterly Issues

In the period from July 1, 2018, through September 30, 2018, KJTH/KXTH/KZTH/KTHF/KTHL addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of July, we had a promotion for our annual "Summer Match Game" contest. Listeners had the opportunity to match prizes on game pieces while listening on-the-air, and then calling in to win those prizes. The ultimate prize was a lake party with radio station staff. We also participated in numerous 4th of July parades; promoted Vacation Bible Schools; and reached 65,000 Facebook page Likes in July. In August, we had a special "Teacher Appreciation" contest. Listeners nominated their favorite teachers, and their comments were read on the air. Two area teachers were selected to win a \$250 Visa Gift Card for their classrooms. Also in August, we held a "Back-To-School" promotion. We partnered with area schools and churches to help neighborhood families and schools receive school supplies, clothes, and food. In September, we heavily promoted "See You At The Pole" prayer events across the listening area. We sent DJ's out to communities in the broadcast area to interview students and report on SYATP events on September 26th. We also sponsored and participated in the Stillwater "Color of Hope Glow InThe Park" 5k Run that helped support Stillwater Life Services. Throughout the three month period, we also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets other issues are listed which were broadcast in the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday morning at 5:30.
