

Re: Public Awareness/Quarterly Issues

In the period from January 1, 2019, through March 31, 2019, KJTH/KXTH/KZTH/KTHF/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of January, our DJ's kicked off the year with the start of annual Elementary, Middle School, and High School visits to speak with students about the importance of getting an education; why the broadcast field is a good career choice; and how their faith in God will help them through their lifetimes. The DJ's went to schools in Ponca City, Enid, and Stillwater. In February, we kicked off our annual Pledge Drive to raise the funds necessary to meet our 2019 non-profit budget. Listeners had the opportunity to win hourly gift prizes, and other special on-air prizes, like Concert tickets. Our DJ's and Promotions Team also engaged listeners at the *Winter Jam* Concert in Wichita, one of Contemporary Christian Music's biggest nationwide concert tours. And, one of our DJ's spoke with students at Messiah Lutheran School in Oklahoma City, a continuation of our annual school visits public speaking program. In March, we interacted with listeners at Oklahoma City's *Winter Jam* concert. We had a special event taken place at a local coffee shop in Bricktown. Some winter jam artists sang for our listeners and were able to have a meet and greet with them. The House FM also hosted *Elevation Worship* in concert in Oklahoma City, and interviewed them for on-air purposes. We also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather.
