Re: Public Awareness / Quarterly Issues

In the period from January 1, 2021, through March 31,2021, radio stations KJTH/KZTH/KXTH/KTHL/KIXO/KTHM/KTHF addressed several issues of public concern. Numerous public service announcements were made on behalf of various local non-profit organizations and churches. In the month of January, we started a new on air and social media contest called the "Artist House Call". Each month a new Christian artist does a Zoom meet and greet with a small group of randomly selected winners. Ten of those winners receive a CD along with one grand prize winner who receives music, merchandise from that specific artist and House FM swag, January's Artist House Call was Jordan Feliz. We had over 100 participants who responded to that contest to be eligible to win a zoom call with Jordan Feliz. In February, we promoted our Valentine's day contest to listeners on air and on social media. This contest was targeted towards married couples who missed their anniversary or honeymoon due to Covid. One lucky couple received an \$250 airbnb gift card to go anywhere they wanted for a weekend. At the end of February, we kicked off our annual Spring Fundraiser to raise the funds necessary to help meet our 2021 non-profit budget. We also partnered with Homeless Alliance during our Spring Fundraiser and with the help of our donors, we were able to donate 3,235 meals to the Homeless Alliance in Oklahoma City. In the month of March, we had a social media contest called "Music of March" where listeners went to our facebook page and voted for their favorite artist/band. There were 32 Christian artists listed to vote for and listeners took advantage of this contest. We had over 12,000 votes for this contest. A randomly selected winner won a merchandise pack from the artist that won the Music of March contest. Also in March, one of our DJ's started a new daily podcast called "Positivity with Haleigh Marie". This podcast was designed to encourage and focus on the positive things in life. The podcast was promoted on our website, on air and on social media. Also the podcast has over 1,000 downloads. The House FM also passed along public information on severe and inclement weather. And, on the attached sheets, other issues are listed which were broadcast on the program "Focus on the Family". "Focus on the Family" airs each weekday from 5-5:30am.
